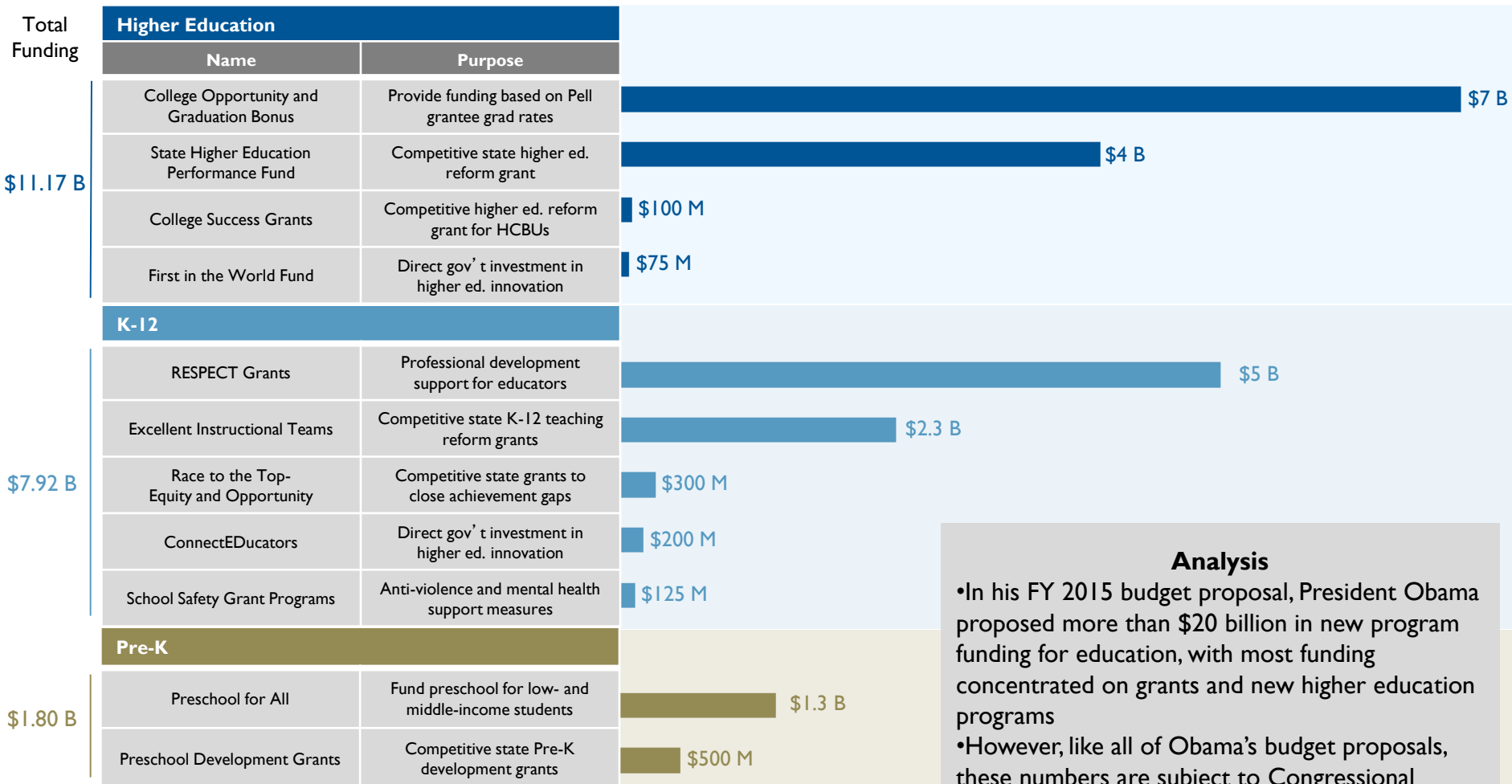


# Several New Education Proposals In Obama's 2015 Budget

## New Education Program in 2015 Budget Proposal



**Analysis**

- In his FY 2015 budget proposal, President Obama proposed more than \$20 billion in new program funding for education, with most funding concentrated on grants and new higher education programs
- However, like all of Obama's budget proposals, these numbers are subject to Congressional approval, which is far from a given
