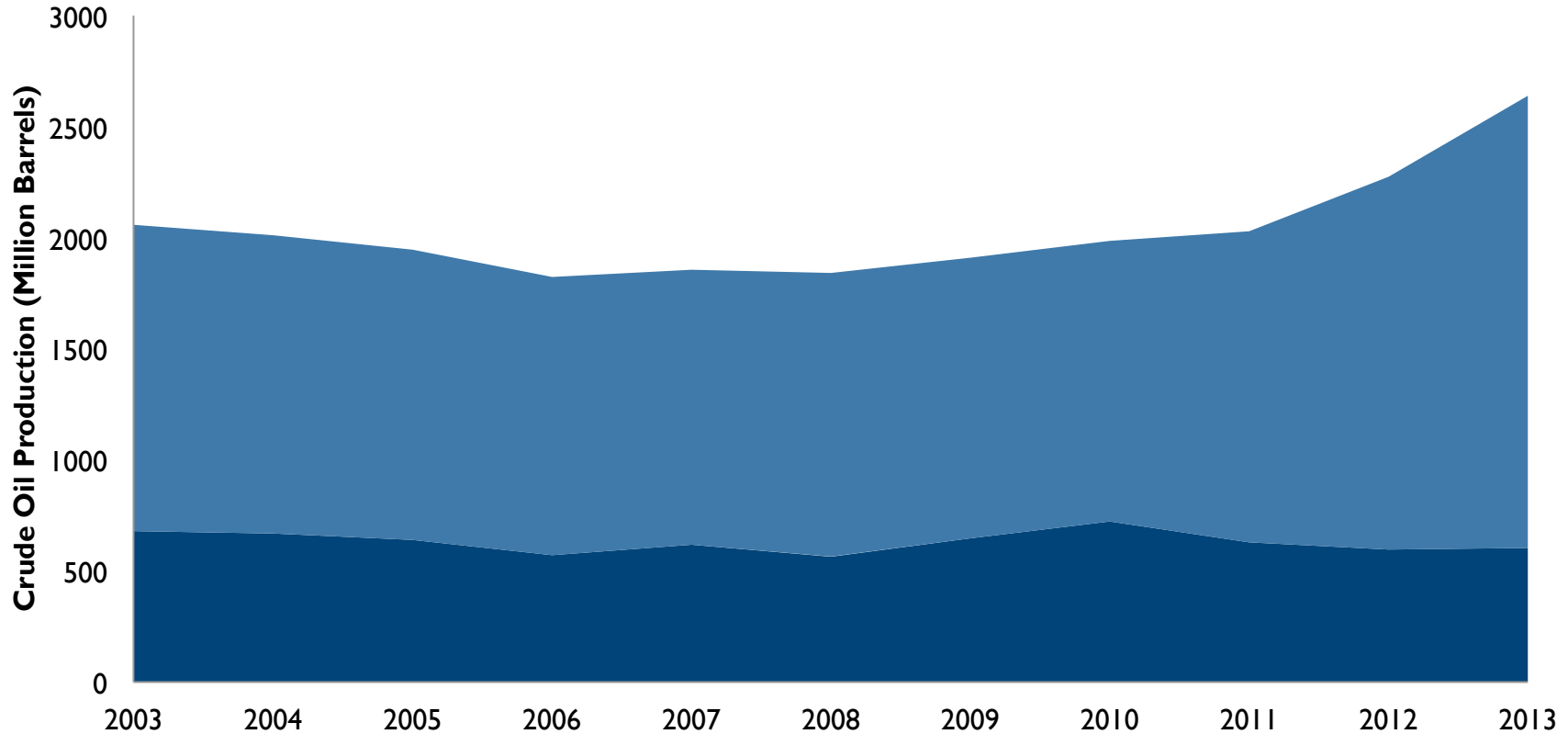


# Share of Oil Production on Private Lands Increasing

## U.S. Crude Oil Production (Million Barrels)

### Analysis

- Since 2003, crude oil production on U.S. private lands has increased by approximately 48%, while production on federal lands has decreased by about 11%
- While high oil prices have stimulated drilling on private lands, production on federal lands—predominately offshore—has been affected by restrictions imposed in the wake of the 2010 Deepwater Horizon oil spill
