World Leaders Meet in Paris to Begin Climate Talks

What is COP21?

- The 21st Conference of Parties
- Annual global forum to assess how nations are dealing with climate change and negotiate agreements for reducing emissions

What is the goal?

To achieve a legally binding agreement to reduce greenhouse gas emissions in order to keep global average temperatures below 2 degrees Celsius of warming over preindustrial global temperatures

Who's going?

- 195 countries and the European Union
- 130 heads of state, including President Obama
- 40,000 people including activists, journalists, business leaders, and city officials

Where and when?

- Paris, France
- Two weeks, Nov. 30-Dec. 11th

What's happening?

- Global leaders have prepared plans to reduce greenhouse gas emissions in advance of the conference in hopes of talking over the pledges during the next two weeks
- China and the US (largest producers of greenhouse gases) have sat down to discuss plans at the conference
- In addition to greenhouse gases, leaders will discuss forest issues and a plan to pay nations to keep carbon stored in forest
