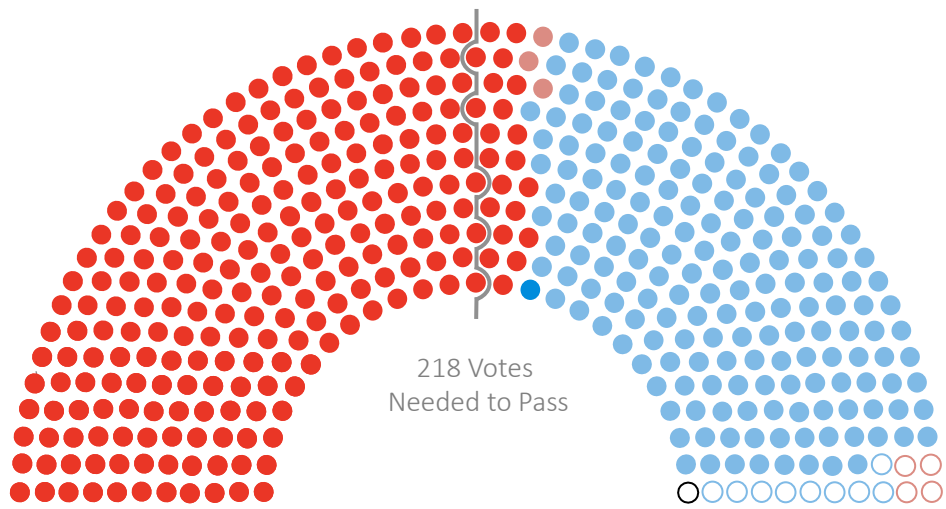


House Passes ACA Repeal Bill, Bill Heads to President's Desk for Expected Veto
