Difference Between a Pledged Delegate and a Superdelegate

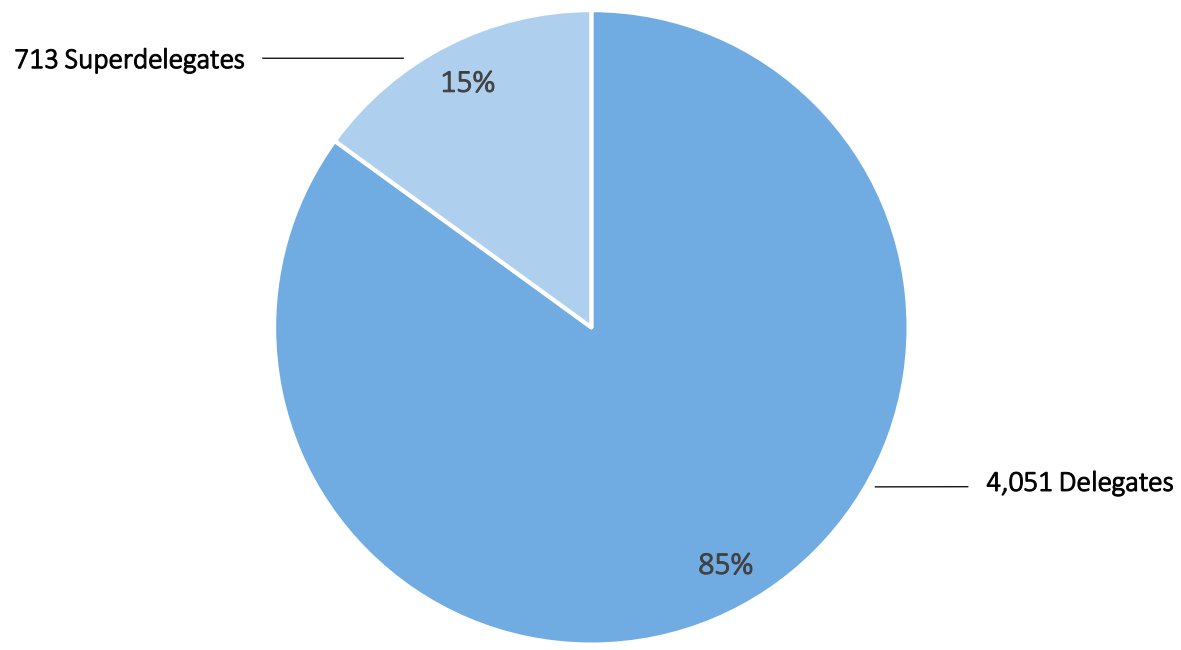
- Pledged delegates are delegates that are allocated to candidates based on statewide caucus or primary results
- Based on the percentage of the vote a candidate wins, pledged delegates agree to vote for that candidate at the Democratic National Convention (DNC)
- Superdelegates are high-ranking Democratic politicians including party leaders, Congressional representatives, Senators and governors
- Superdelegates are free to choose whom they wish to vote for at the DNC
