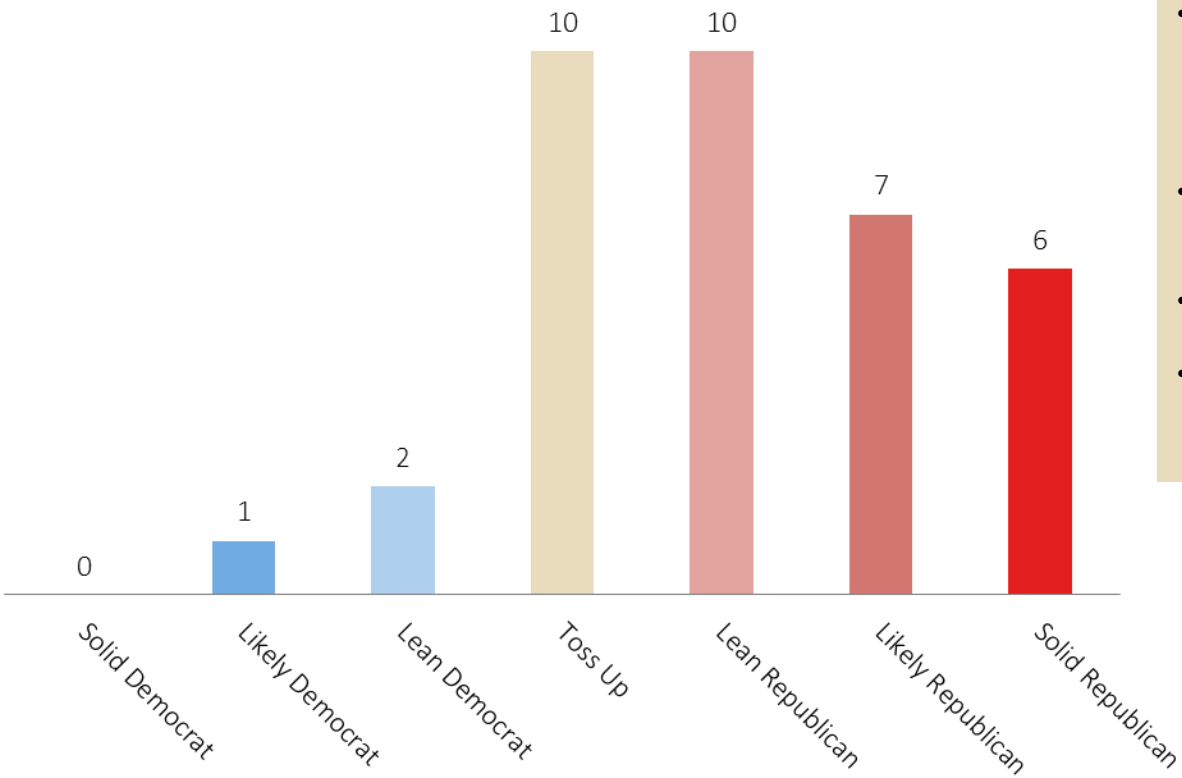


Cook Political Report: Democrat Challengers with Funding Face Tough House Elections in 2016

Republican Seats Where A Democrat Challenger Has Over \$100k in the Bank



Analysis

- A total of 36 Democrats running to challenge Republican House incumbents have over \$100,000; 52 GOP incumbents are in districts where Obama won at least 47% of the vote
- Democrats would need to pick up 30 GOP held seats to take back the House, which may require about 50 seats in play
- House redistricting has also opened seats to Democrats in Florida and Virginia
- Even with Trump or Cruz at the top of the ticket, it would be difficult for Democrats to recapture the House
