	Barack Obama	Obama condemned inversions at a specially convened press conference Tuesday, saying that they were: "One of the most insidious loopholes out there. It sticks the rest of us with the tab and it makes hard-working Americans feel like the deck is stacked against them." Obama called for Congress to pass legislation to close loophole as: "only Congress can close it for good."
	Hillary Clinton	In a tweet, Clinton wrote: "Glad to hear Pfizer is calling off the merger. We need to close the loopholes that let corporations escape paying their taxes." Clinton previously criticized the merger in November, citing "deep concerns" and calling upon congress to take action to block such inversions.
	Bernie Sanders	Tagging his statement from November in which he called for the White House to block the merger, Sanders endorsed the Obama administration's decision: "Pfizer's merger was a transparent attempt to dodge U.S. taxes. I applaud President Obama for taking decisive action."
A81	Donald Trump	No comment on the cancelled deal as yet. Trump has made mixed statements on the issue; in November, he said that "The fact that Pfizer is leaving our country with a tremendous loss of jobs is disgusting. He also said that the inversion was understandable, and that there was "no other way you can stop it really other than lowering the taxes."
	Ted Cruz	No comment on deal, however Cruz would like to see corporate tax abolished
