## The Senate Adopted Two Amendments for the Reauthorization Bill

Amendment	Vote	Summary
"Security and Terrorism Prevention"  Sponsored by: John Thune (R) South Dakota Commerce Committee Chairman	85-10 Passed	<ul> <li>Focused on ensuring that airport employees who carry credentials are sufficiently screened and present no risk to the public and airport security.</li> <li>Provides continued authorization and further expansion of TSA Pre-Check program.</li> </ul>
"Law Enforcement Training"  Sponsored by: Martin Heinrich (D) New Mexico	91-5 Passed	<ul> <li>Authorizes training for law enforcement at airports on responding to incidents of mass casualties and active shooters.</li> <li>Increases security in areas before security checkpoints where passengers tend to congregate, like ticket counters or the line for TSA checkpoints.</li> </ul>

- The Senate is hoping to pass the bill early next week, but clean energy tax breaks are holding up the deal.
- Both amendments are likely a reaction to the **recent** attacks in Brussels, Belgium.
