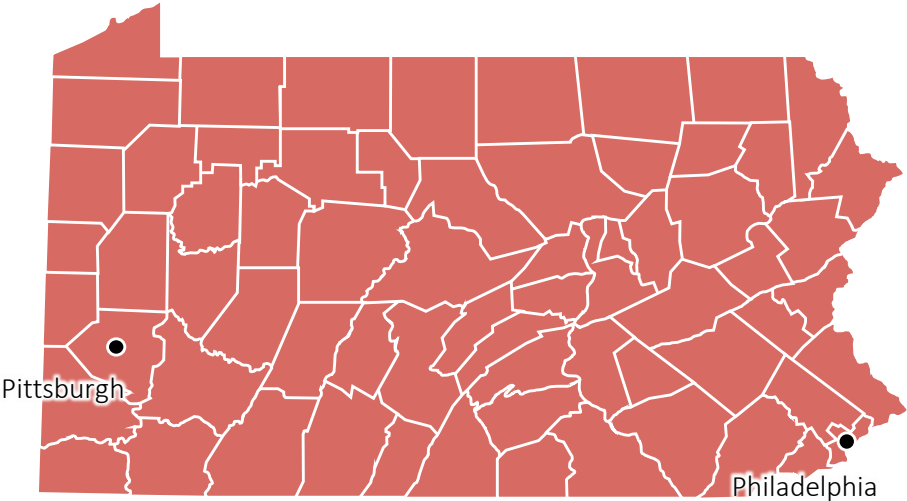


# Donald Trump Wins Pennsylvania, But GOP Rules Make Delegate Count Difficult

### Analysis

- Donald Trump swept Pennsylvania winning many counties with over 65% of the vote, however only 17 of Pennsylvania’s delegates are pledged to follow the popular vote. **54 delegates will be sent to the convention unbound.**
- Ted Cruz failed to find a strong, concentrated base of support in the state and only managed to mobilize small numbers of voters across many counties.
