Timing

• The polls are open from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.

Delegates

• There are a total of 34 delegates at stake, 22 of which are awarded to the statewide winner and 9 are awarded by congressional district (three to the winner of each of the three districts). The last three are unbound.

What to Watch For

- Now that Trump is the last man standing on the GOP side, the real contest will be the Democratic primary in West Virginia.
- A poll by MetroNews was conducted before Cruz and Kasich dropped out gave Trump a commanding 57 percent lead in the Republican primary.
- With Trump now the only option for Republicans, one thing to watch for on the Republican side will be turnout.
- At a rally in Charleston last week, Trump made the odd decision to urge his supporters to stay home on Tuesday since the GOP primary was no longer competitive.
