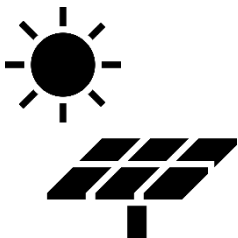

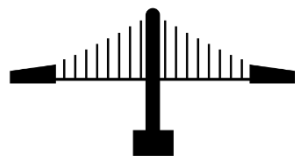

G7 Statements Emphasize the Need To Expand and Improve Public Goods and Establish Norms For Behavior

Main Points From G7 Appendix Documents

Document Topic	Main Goals
Infrastructure Investment	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ensure environmental, efficiency, and quality standards are improved and standardized• Improve governance structures for public-private partnerships and international infrastructure banks
Health Care	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Strengthen global funding and coordination of pandemic response• Seek to obtain universal health care coverage• Greater R&D for health care
Women’s Empowerment	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Increase women’s access to education and participation in schooling• Promote women in justice and security sectors to help with conflict resolution and limit women’s abuse by these sectors
Cyber Security	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Promote access to digital technologies and internet connection• Create and foster global norms about cybersecurity through national security collaboration on cyber issues
Corruption	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Create greater transparency in public procurement process• Greater information and security cooperation to limit trans-national corruption
Terrorism	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Greater intelligence sharing and border security cooperation• Coordinate with NGOs and private sector to foster civil society in vulnerable and failing states as a way of combating violent extremism
