Analysis

- While California is often seen as a very liberal state, many of the state's GOP voters seem ready for Trump to lead their party, especially those in the more rural and mountainous regions of the state.
- The San Francisco Bay Area stands out as a solid anti-Trump region, with 1 in 3 GOP voters turning out to vote for other candidates.
