
Donald Trump Earns Votes in New Mexico, But Anti-Trump Voters Make Their Voices Heard

New Mexico GOP Primary Results, by County



Analysis

- Almost half of the state's population identifies as Hispanic or Latino, therefore Donald Trump's recent comments against Judge Gonzalo Curiel about his Mexican heritage most likely hurt his standing with potential voters.
- Several counties had as many as 40% of voters opting to vote for other candidates.
