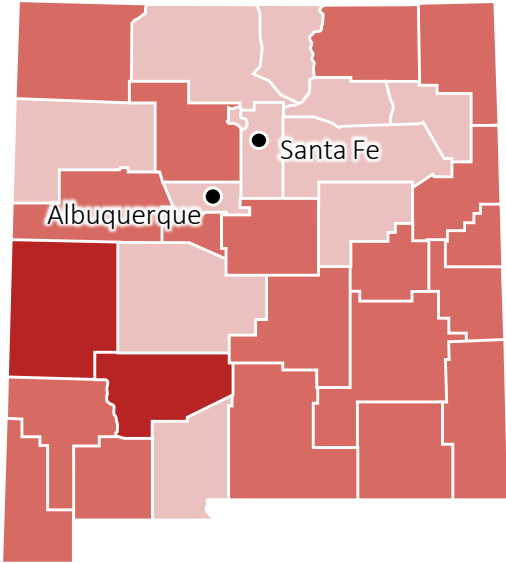


Donald Trump Earns Votes in New Mexico, But Anti-Trump Voters Make Their Voices Heard

New Mexico GOP Primary Results, by County

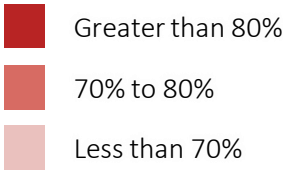
| Candidate | Votes | Pct. | Delegates |
|--------------|--------|-------|-----------|
| Donald Trump | 73,747 | 70.7% | 24 |
| Ted Cruz | 13,836 | 13.3% | - |
| John Kasich | 7,869 | 7.5% | - |



Analysis

- Almost half of the state’s population identifies as Hispanic or Latino, **therefore Donald Trump’s recent comments against Judge Gonzalo Curiel about his Mexican heritage** most likely hurt his standing with potential voters.
- Several counties had as many as 40% of voters opting to vote for other candidates.
