**Bobby Scott** – US Representative, VA-3

- As the first African American elected to congress from Virginia since reconstruction, most commentators think that Scott is the most likely pick.
- Scott, a progressive, was named VP of the Democrat's gun violence protection task force. He notably opposed the PATRIOT act after 9/11 and supports boosting funding to reduce juvenile crime.



**Don Beyer –** US Representative VA-8

- Beyer, a former lieutenant governor and ambassador, has proven his ability to raise money and win in vote-rich Northern Virginia.
- He is a first term congressman in a district covers the wealthy and heavily Democratic Northern Virginia suburbs.



**Gerald Connolly –** US Representative, VA-11

• Connolly, the former chairman of the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors, is a third term representative who has also proven his ability to raise money and win in Northern Virginia.

- If Tim Kaine is elected Vice President, Virginia Governor Terry McAuliffe will select a replacement, who would likely serve for about a year before a special election would take place.
- Other potential candidates include Delegate Jennifer L. McClellan, a corporate lawyer; Molly Ward, McAuliffe's secretary of natural resources; and Levar Stoney, a candidate for Mayor of Richmond.
