40-year-old, Republican Evan McMullin announced his bid for President on Tuesday. A former CIA Officer, McMullin has never held elected office. McMullin is a foreign affairs expert with a focus on Middle East counterterrorism. He spent 11 years working for the clandestine arm of the CIA as an operations officer in Asia, Africa, and the Middle East. Before joining the CIA, he volunteered for the United Nations Human Rights Council in Jordan as a refugee resettlement officer. Since retiring from the CIA, McMullin has worked in both the private and public sector. From 2010 to 2013, he was a mergers and acquisitions associate at Goldman Sachs. He since has moved on to Capitol Hill, serving both as an advisor to the House Committee on Foreign Affairs and, more recently, as chief policy director to the House Republican Conference. McMullin is a member of the Council on Foreign Relations and the International Advisory Board of Brigham Young University. Veteran Republican strategist and fellow Never Trump enthusiast, Rick Wilson, is assisting McMullin with his campaign.
