The WFP uses its resources to advocate for legislation that would protect equal pay for equal work.



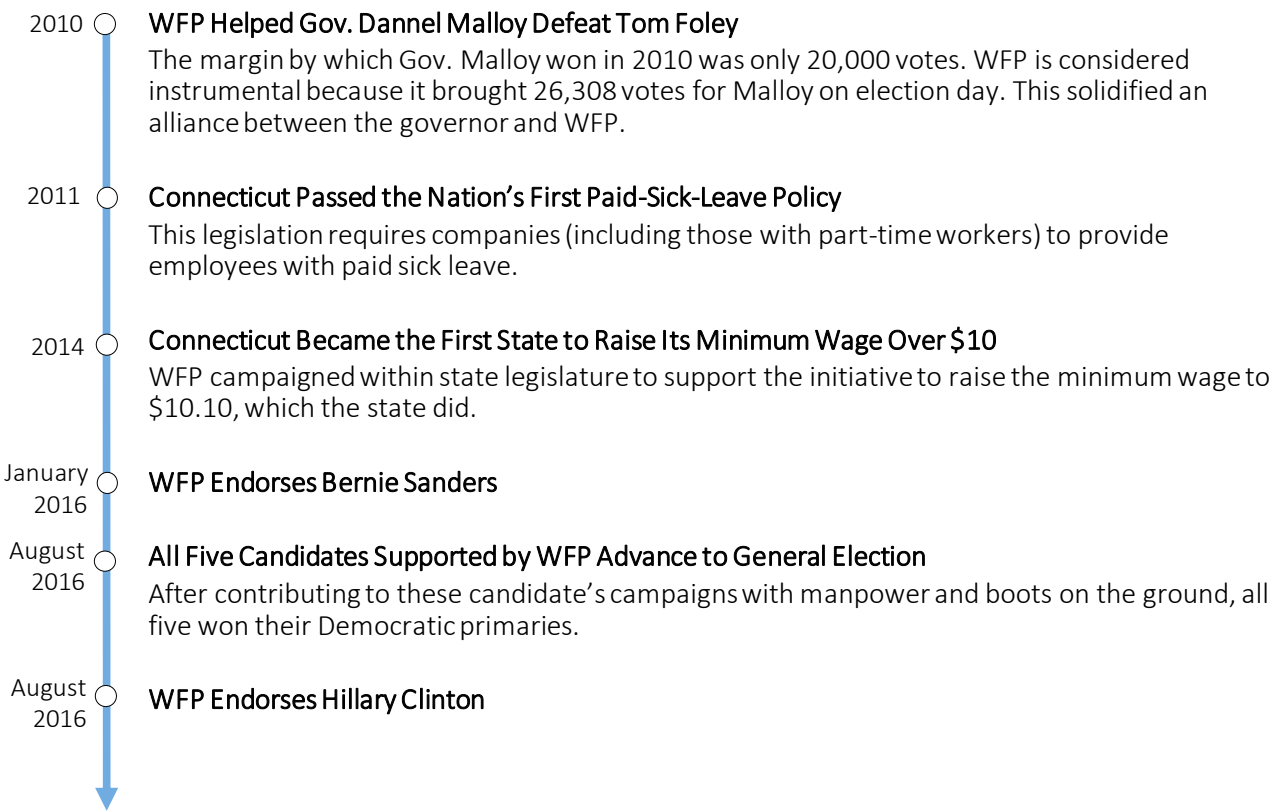
\$15 Minimum Wage

WFP Impact on Connecticut Labor Policy

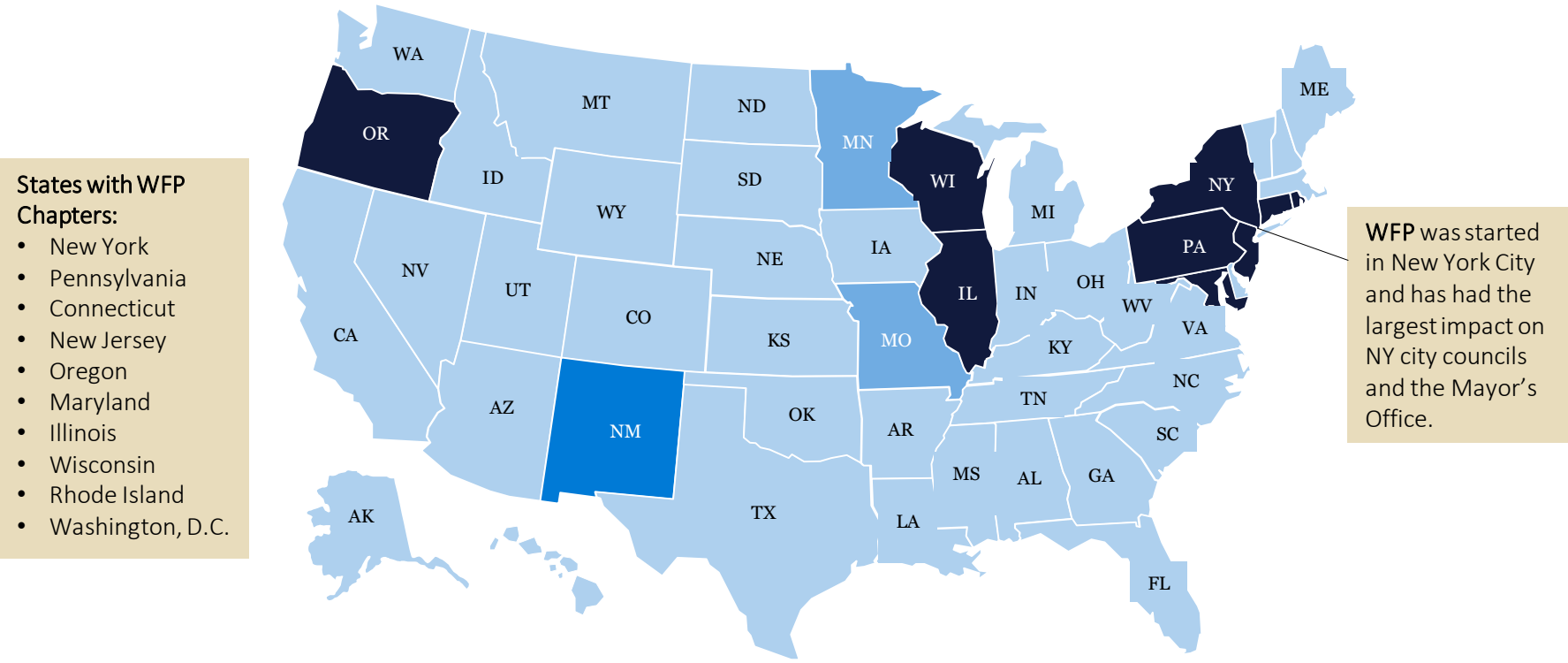
