


Trump Still Maintains Higher Support Among Military Households In Spite of Khan Controversy

% of Military Household Members Who Support Presidential Candidates



Broken Down By Gender



% of Military Household Members Who Support Presidential Candidates


Broken Down By Race/Ethnicity

Margin of GOP Presidential Candidates' Advantage With Military/Veteran Vote




