Analysis

- The Cook Political Report rates this race as a "Toss Up."
- After losing his home state of Florida to Trump in the presidential primary, Rubio decided at the last minute to run for reelection to the Senate and handily defeated Beruff, who aligned himself with Trump.
- Grayson's Senate bid suffered from a House ethics investigation into his offshore hedge funds and allegations from his ex-wife that he physically abused her.

- Alan Grayson hoped that his wife, Dena, could fill his seat, but she came in a distant third in her primary race on the same night Alan lost his bid for the Senate
