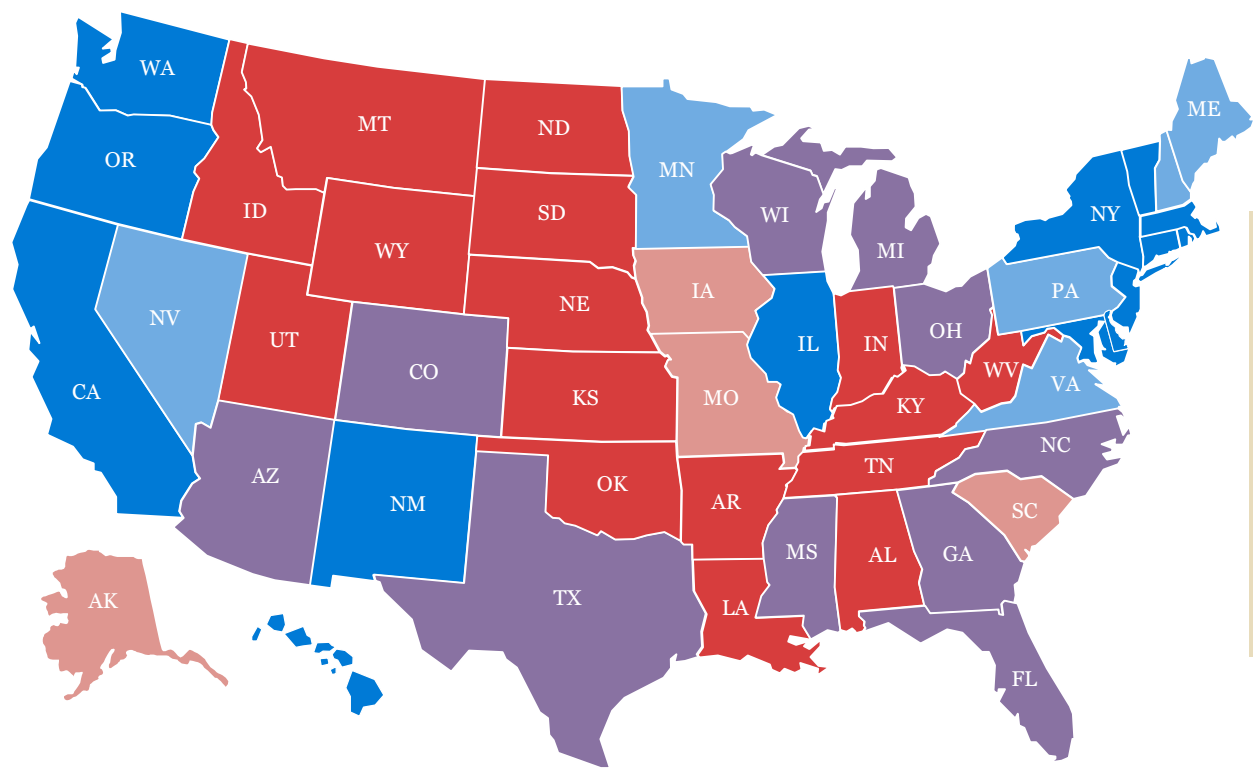


# Washington Post 50-State Poll Shows How The Electoral College Map May Change in 2016

■ Solid Democrat ■ Lean Democrat ■ Toss-Up ■ Lean Republican ■ Solid Republican



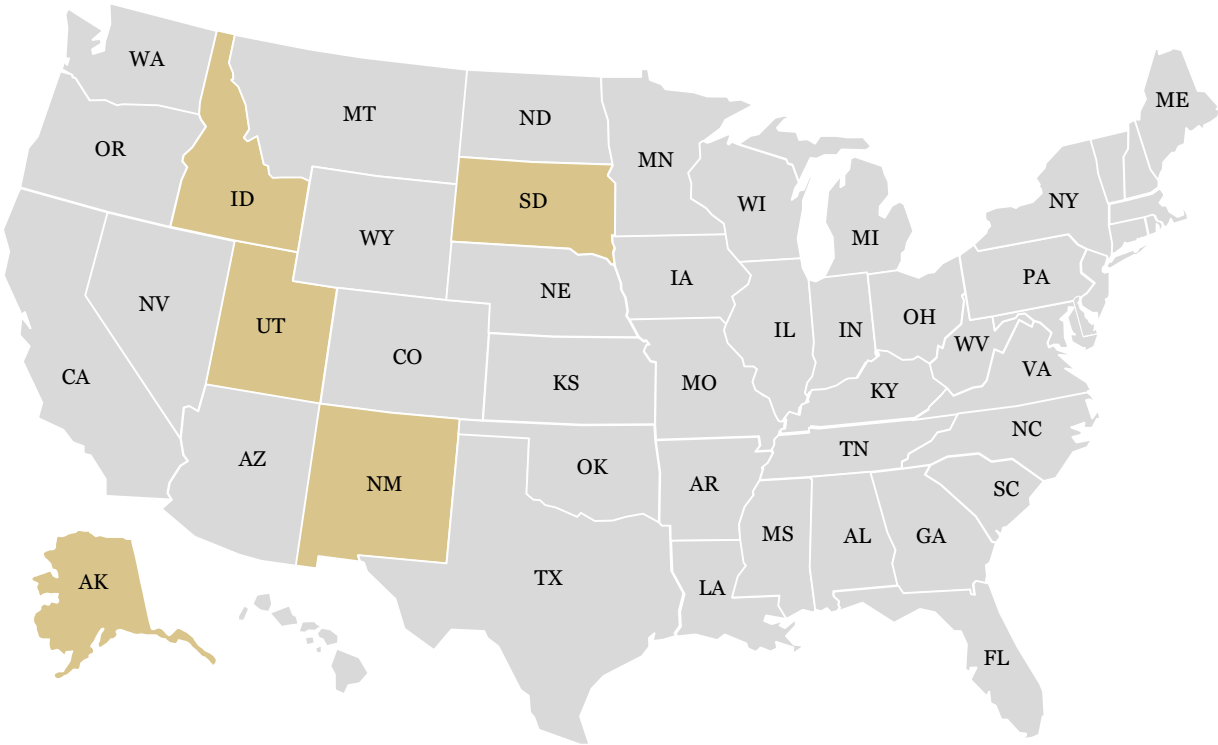
**Analysis**

- In this poll the traditional swing states of Pennsylvania and Virginia lean towards Clinton by margins of 4 and 8 points respectively.
- Texas and Mississippi are two historically red states that may be in play for Clinton this year. Both states have consistently voted for Republican presidential candidates since 1980.

# Gary Johnson Continues to Make Progress In the Mountain West

## States Where Gary Johnson Polls Well



State	Gary Johnson	Hillary Clinton	Donald Trump
NM	25%	37%	29%
UT	23%	27%	34%
SD	19%	29%	37%
AK	19%	31%	38%
ID	19%	25%	44%

### Analysis

- Between these five states, Gary Johnson has the potential to deny Clinton and Trump up to 21 electoral votes.
- Trump has the most to lose to Johnson as he currently polls better than Clinton in four of these five states.
