
Clinton will likely win the Electoral College as she has 278 solid, likely and lean Democrat electoral votes

Analysis

- Cook's final electoral report has 278 votes as Democrat, 46 votes as toss-up and 214 votes as Republican
- For Trump to pull off an upset, he would have to win the toss up-states (NC and FL) and pick up some lean Democrat states like Colorado, Nevada and/or New Hampshire
- The odds of Trump doing this are incredibly slim; he has about as much of a chance as Clinton does of picking up Arizona or Georgia
- Overall, Clinton has a lot more pathways to get to 270 electoral votes than Trump making it likely that she will win the presidency
