

1952-2016, as of November 11th at 10:38 pm



1952-2016, reported as of November 11th at 10:39 AM



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



Composition of the 115th Senate map






Control of the 114th Senate (2014-2016)







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

2016 House election results map







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

Map of state gubernatorial election results, by party







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


Party control at beginning of 112th Congress (2011-2013)


Party control at beginning of 113th Congress (2013-2015)

Republican party regains congressional control with senate majority after 2014 Midterm elections


Party control at beginning of 114th Congress (2015-2017)

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


Marijuana ballot initiative results



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
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Voter turnout at lowest rates since 2004
