
Republican Attorneys General Association votes to reverse the "incumbency rule," and Dems signal reciprocation

Analysis

- Before, AG associations would not target incumbents seeking reelection
- 31 states and DC have elections for attorney general in 2017 or 2018
- 18 have Republican incumbents
- 14 have Democratic incumbents
