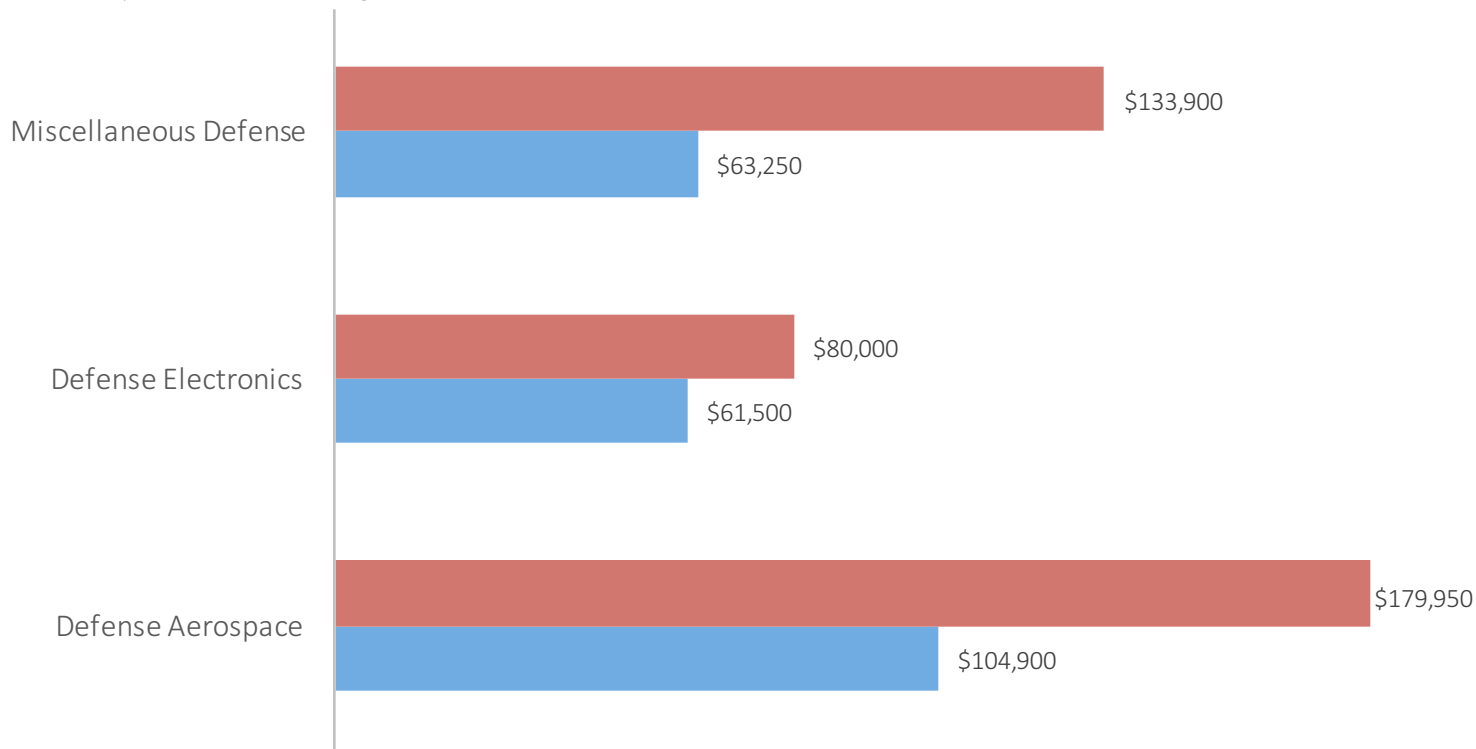
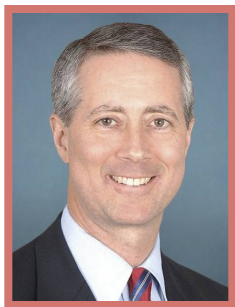

Chairman Mac Thornberry (R-TX) Ranking Member Adam Smith (D-WA)



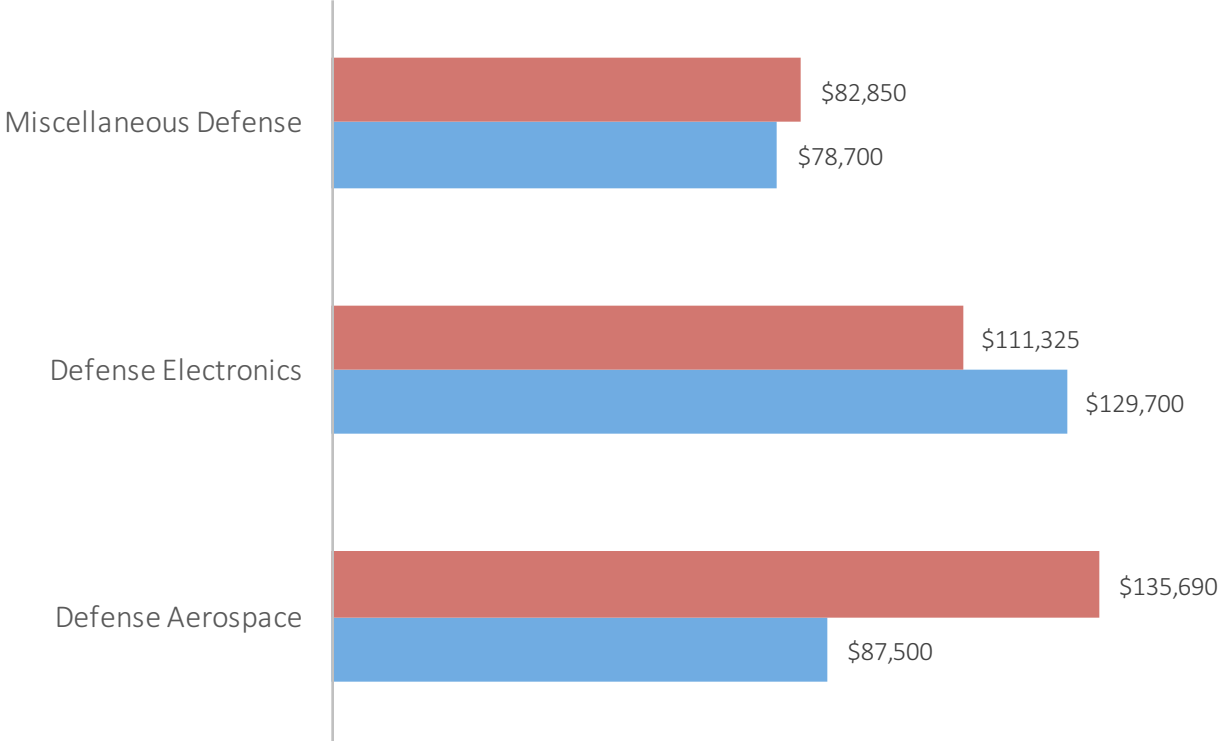
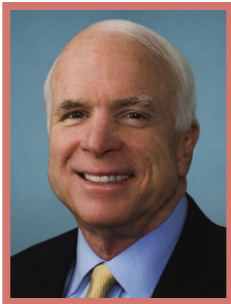

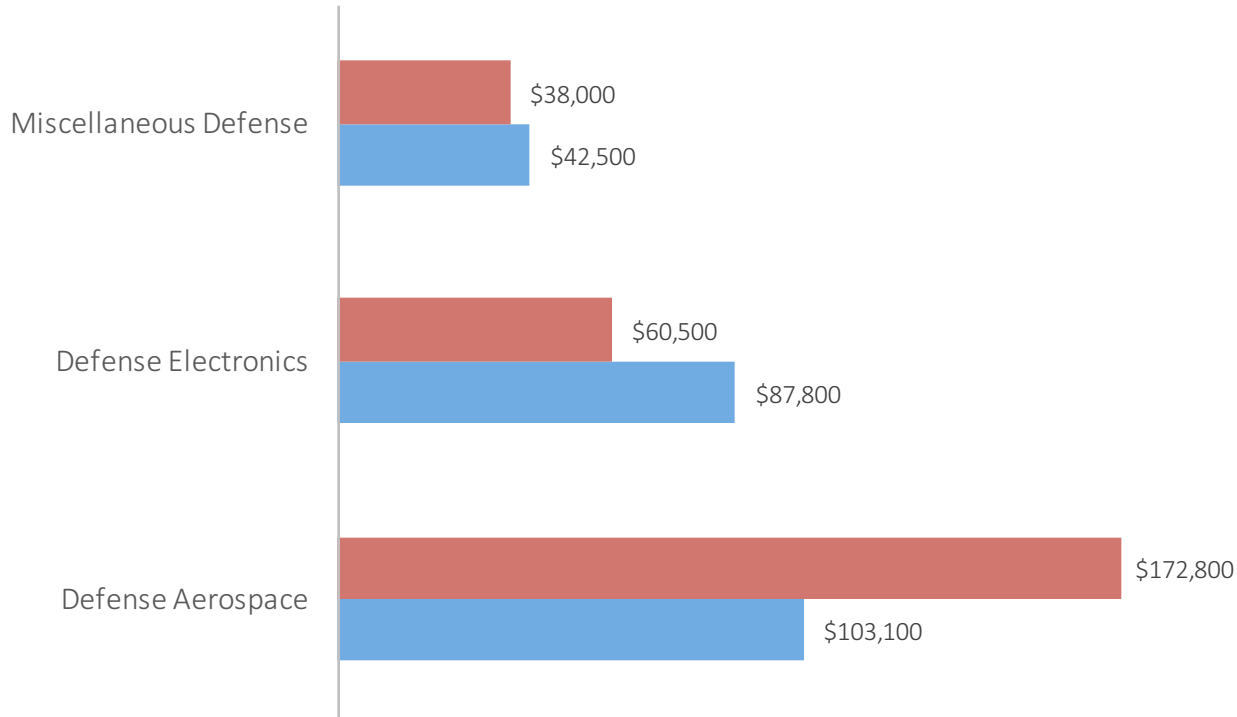
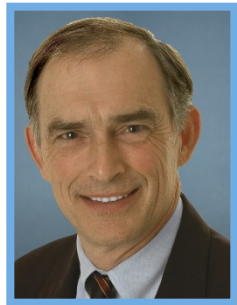

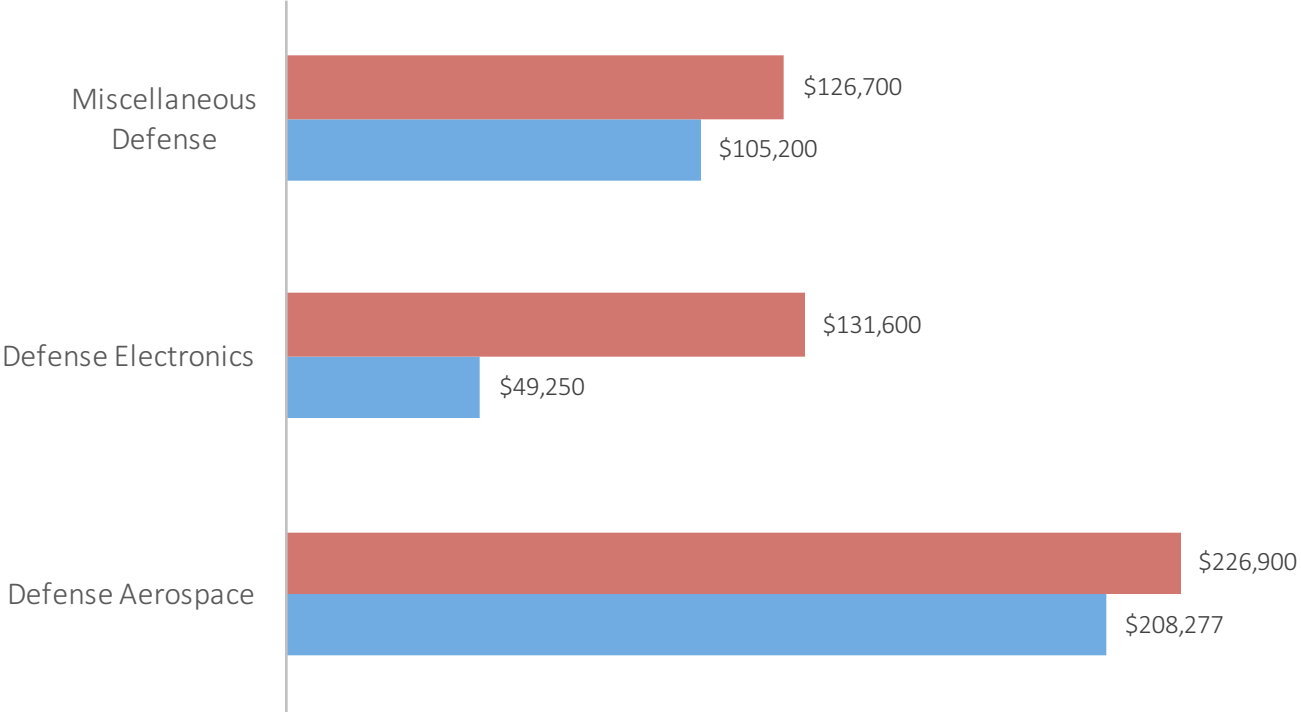
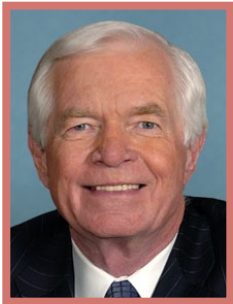
