Background

- New Mexico and California have the largest shares of Latinas working full time, year-round
- In California and New Jersey, Latinas face the largest wage gaps; Latinas in New Jersey are also paid 43 cents for every dollar made by a non-Hispanic white man
- 40% of Latina mothers bring in 40% or more of their household's income
