


Reps. Upton and Long flip to yes: AHCA may pass the House with new amendments

Influential Republicans on AHCA with McArthur/Upton Amendments

- CNN reports 21 no votes; WaPo reports 20; Huffington reports 19; Hill reports 17; NYT, NBC report 16
- The Freedom Caucus officially voted to support the bill, meaning that the bill can count on 80% of the Freedom Caucus members votes
- The bill can only afford to lose 22 GOP votes, the House currently has 238 GOP members due to the four vacancies
- Rep. Fred Upton and Rep. Billy Long switched to yes on Wednesday morning after receiving a concession amendment. Their amendment brought many members to yes
