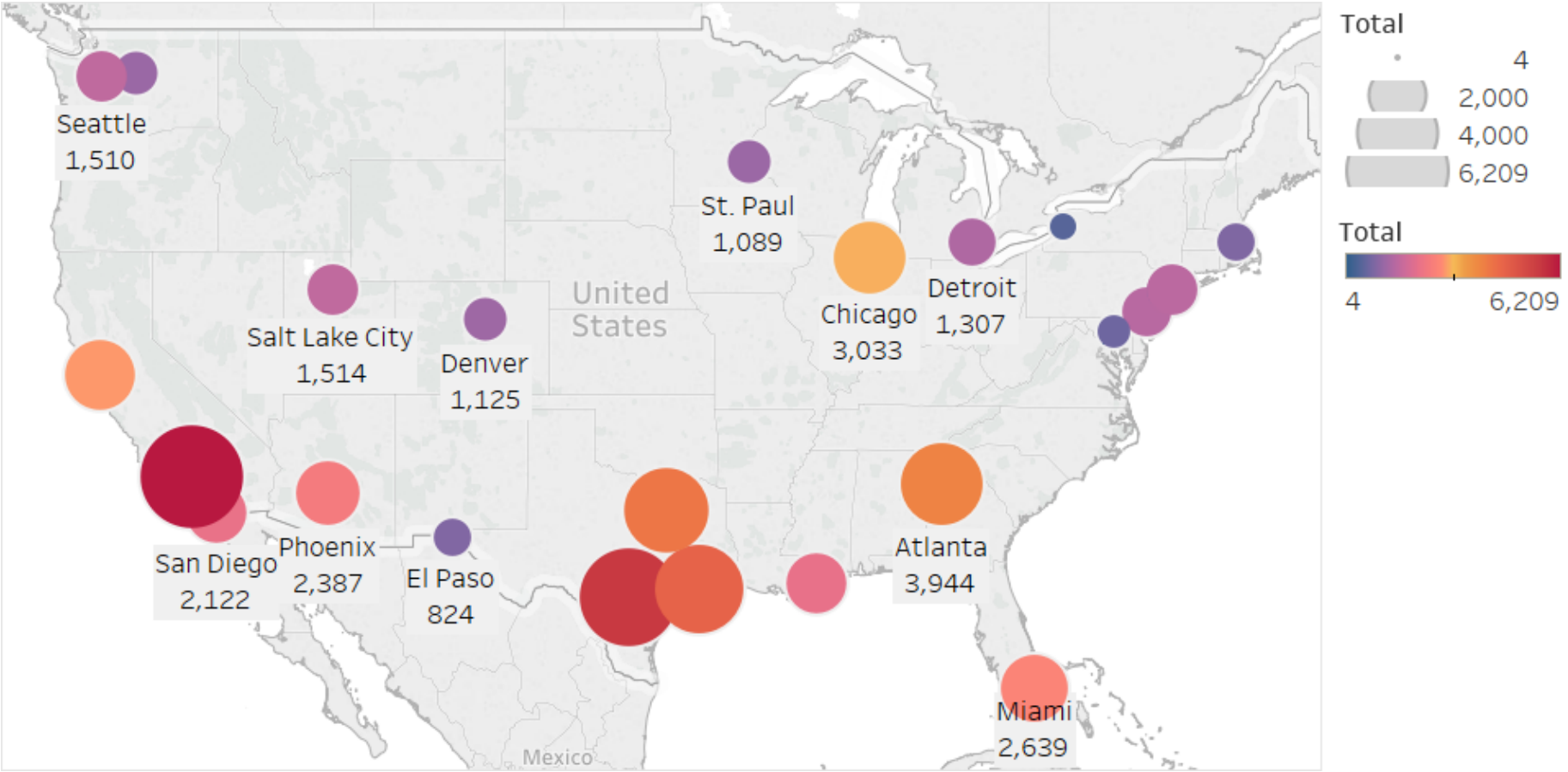

ICE/ERO administrative arrest data, 1/20/14 – 4/29/14

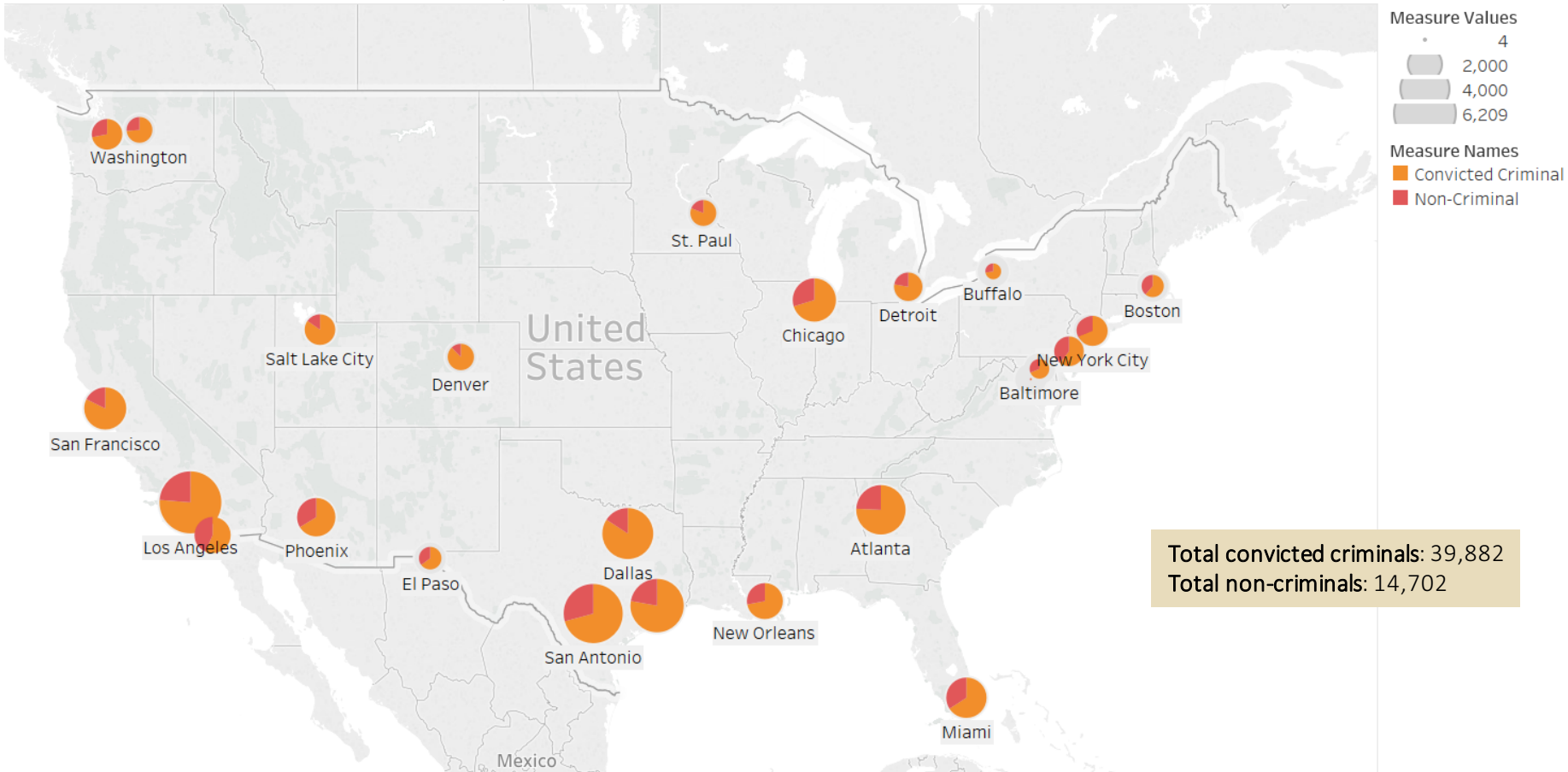

ICE/ERO administrative arrest data, 1/20/14 – 4/29/14

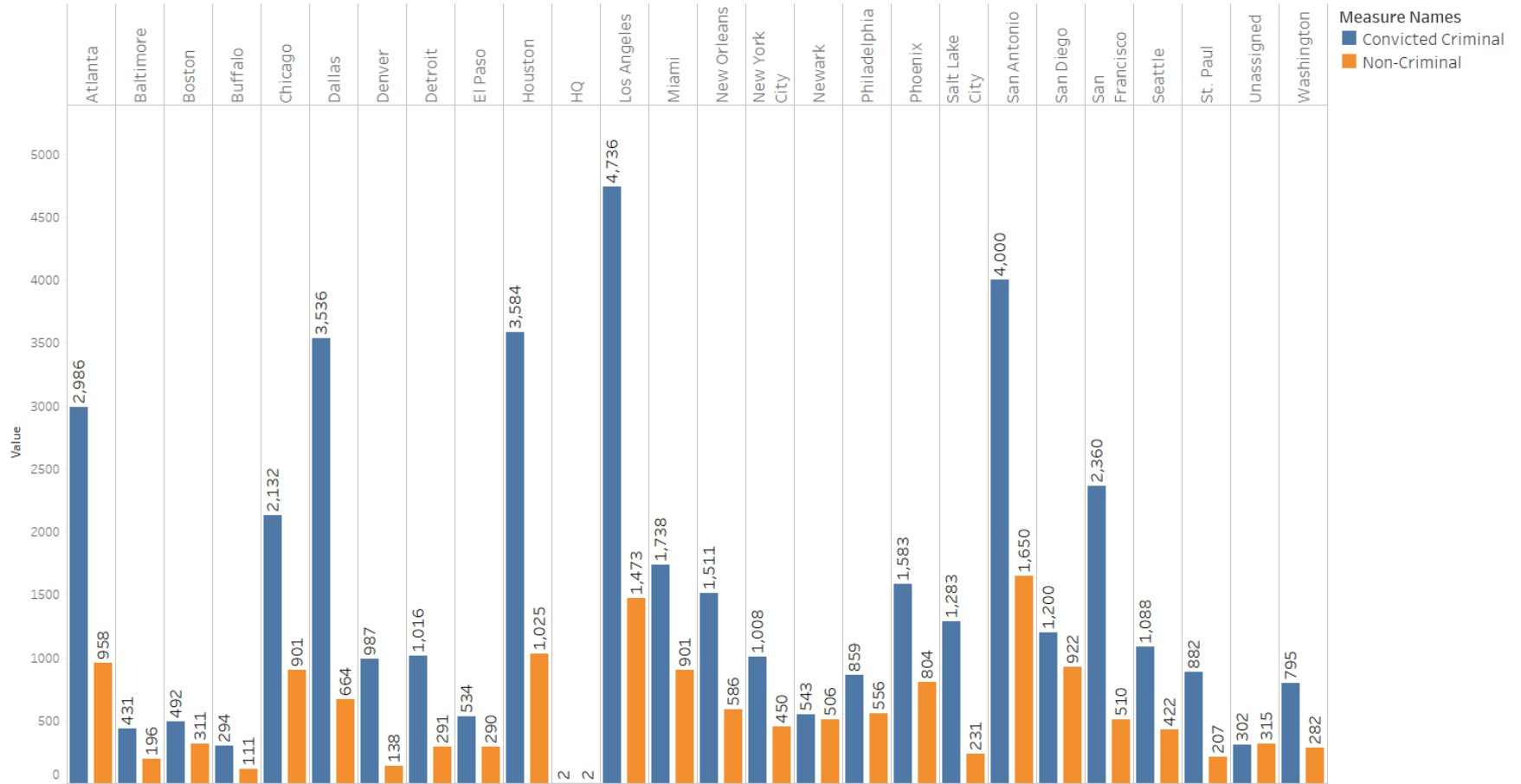

ICE/ERO administrative arrest data, 1/20/14 – 4/29/14

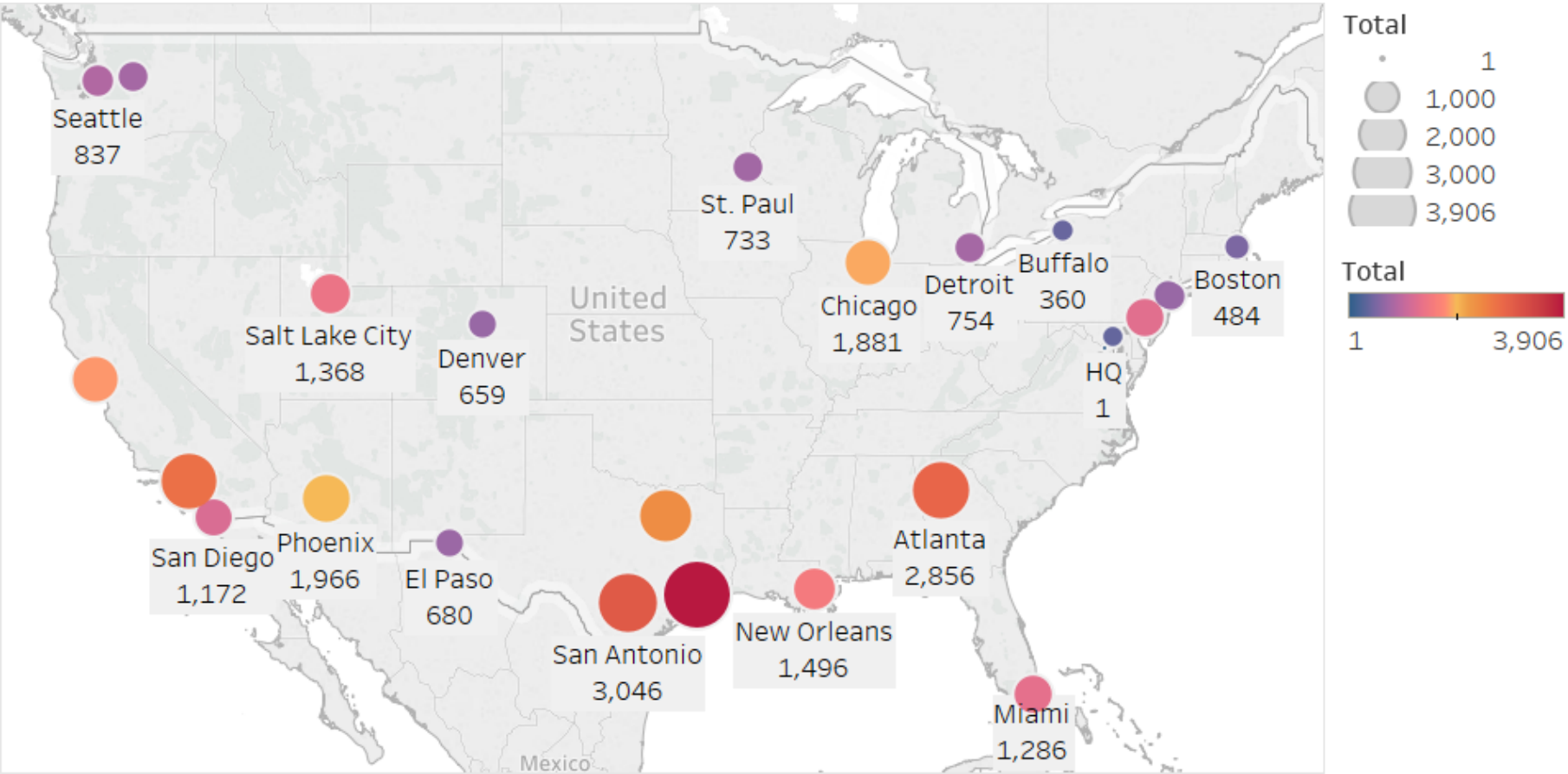

ICE/ERO administrative arrest data, 1/20/15 – 4/29/15



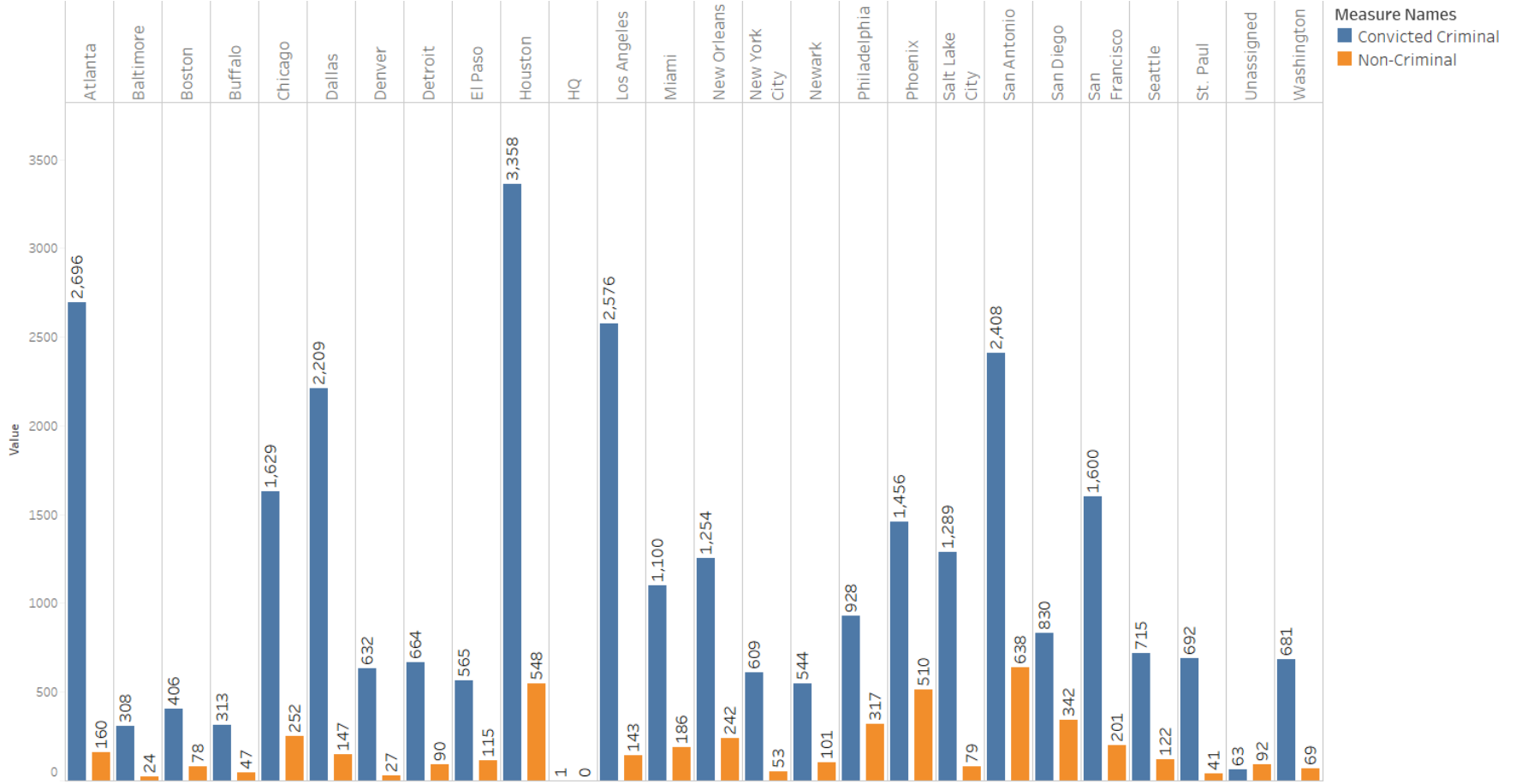

ICE/ERO administrative arrest data, 1/20/15 – 4/29/15

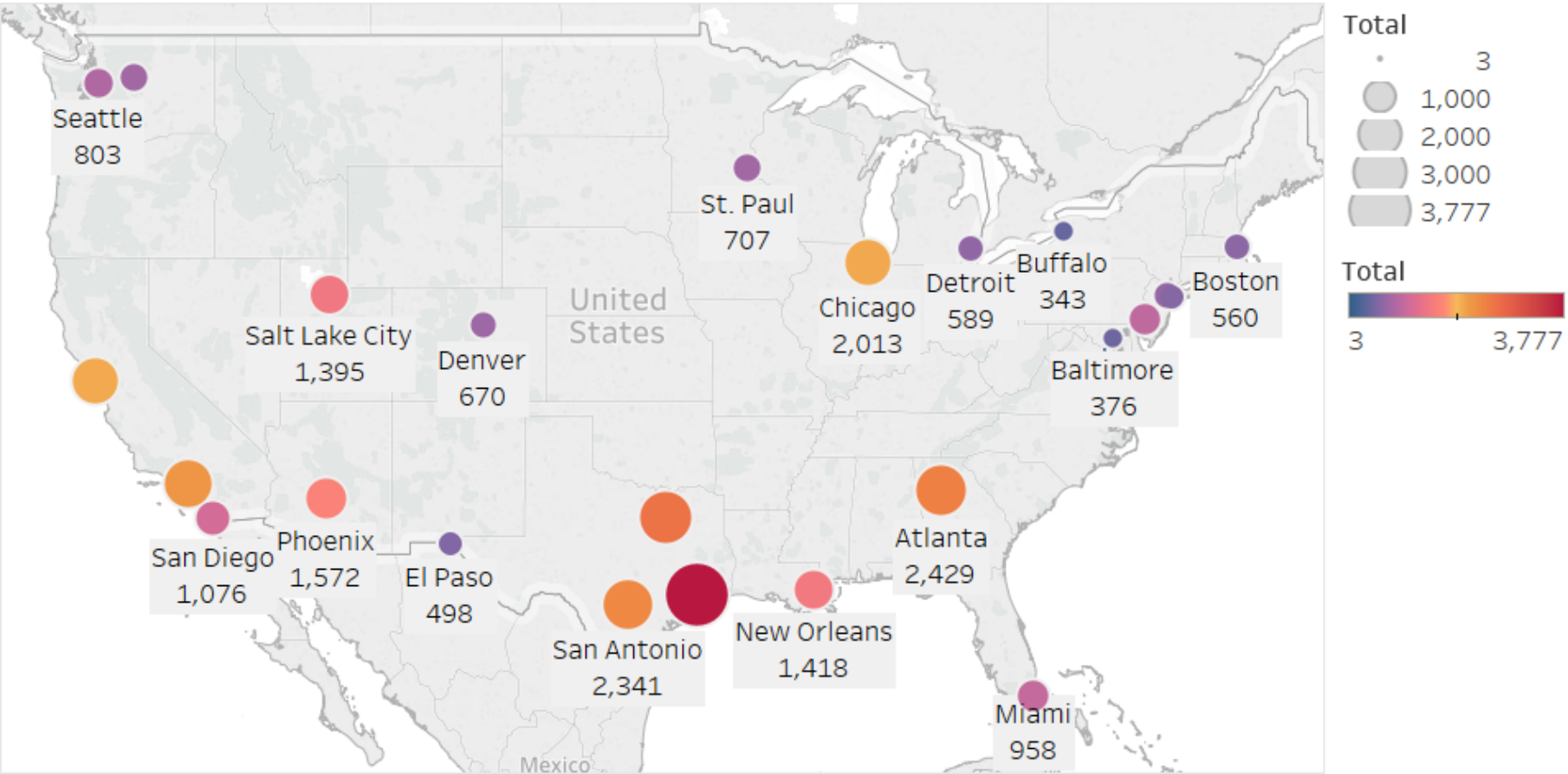

ICE/ERO administrative arrest data, 1/20/16 – 4/29/16



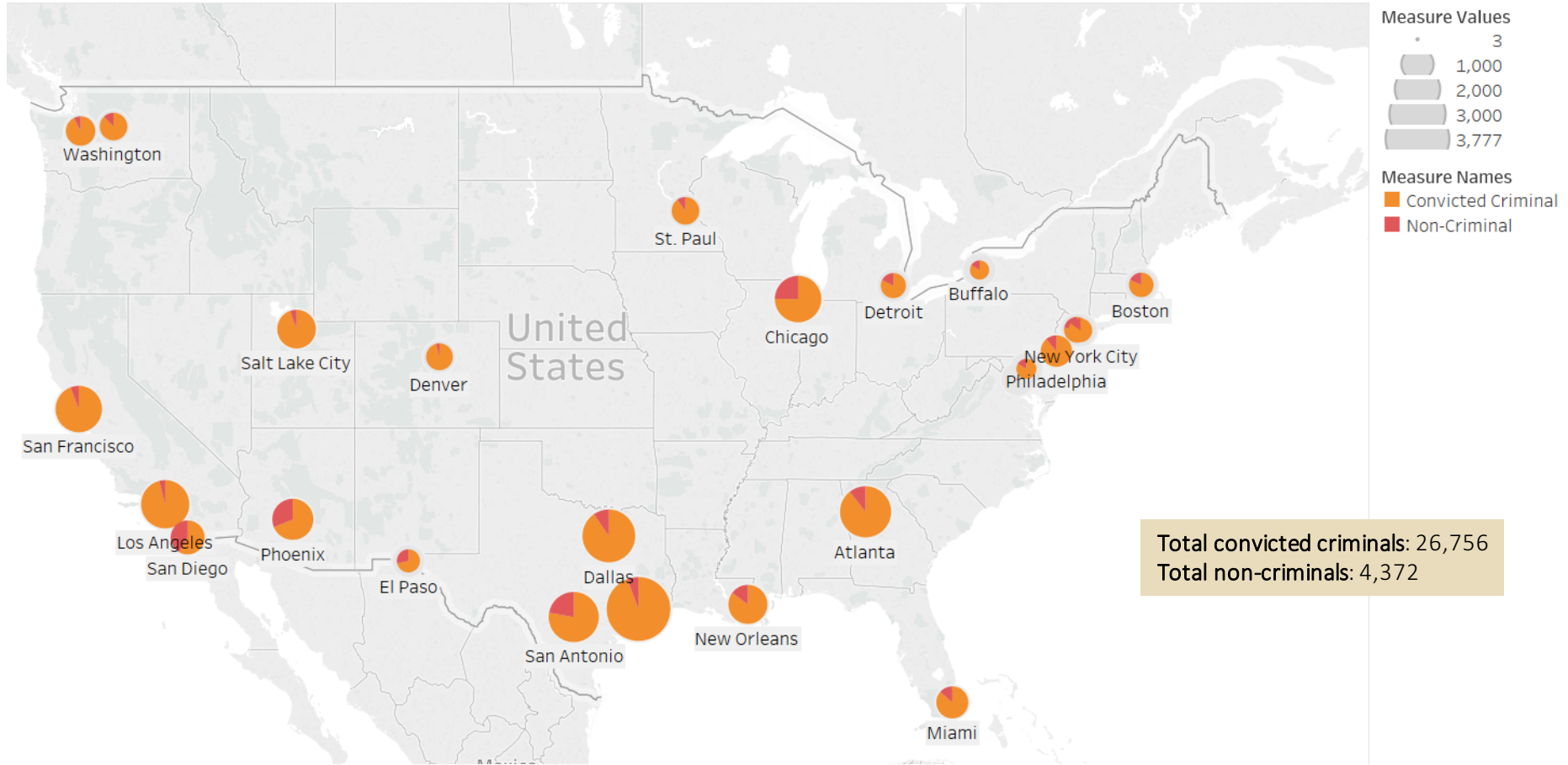

ICE/ERO administrative arrest data, 1/20/16 – 4/29/16

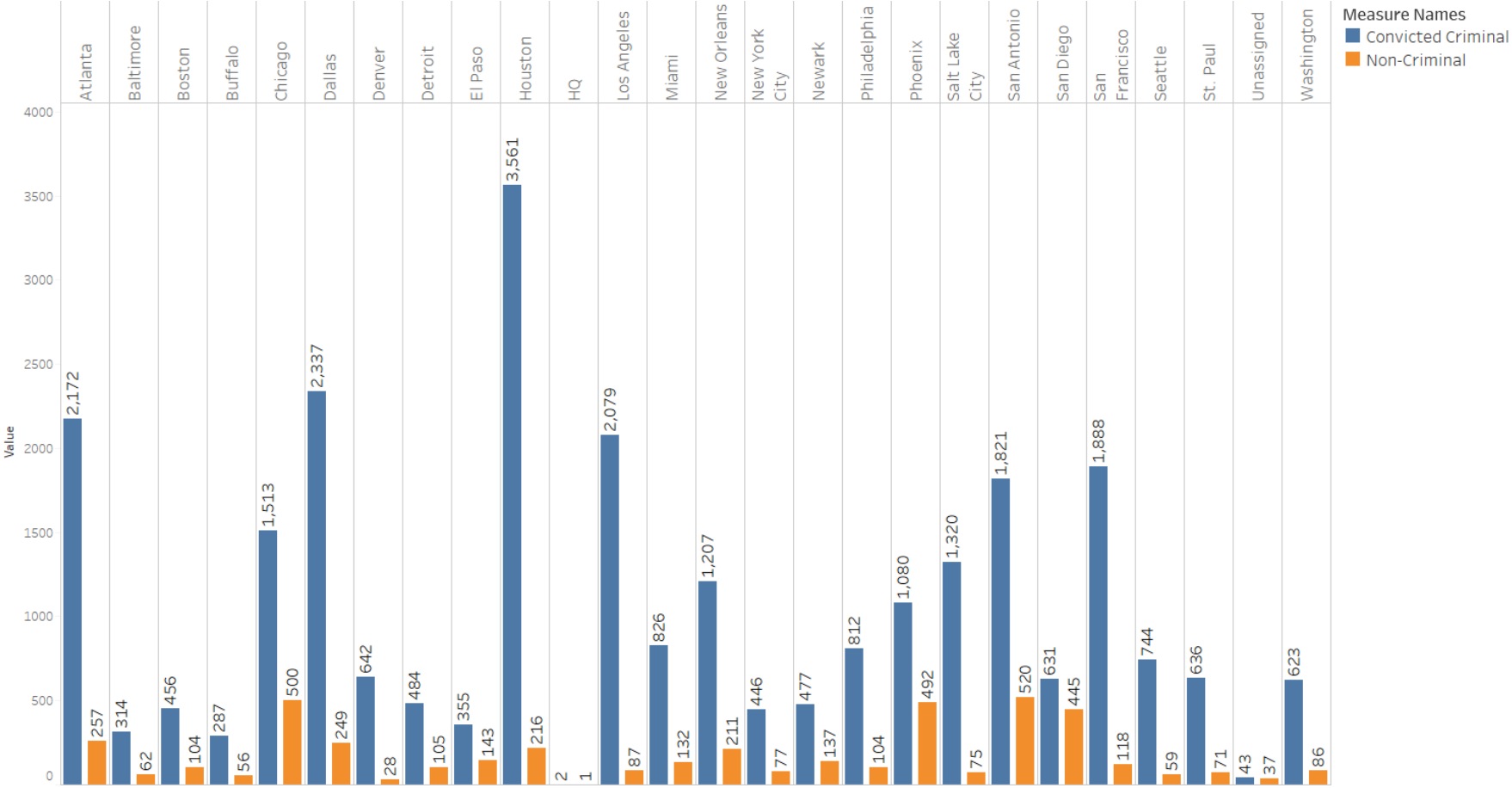

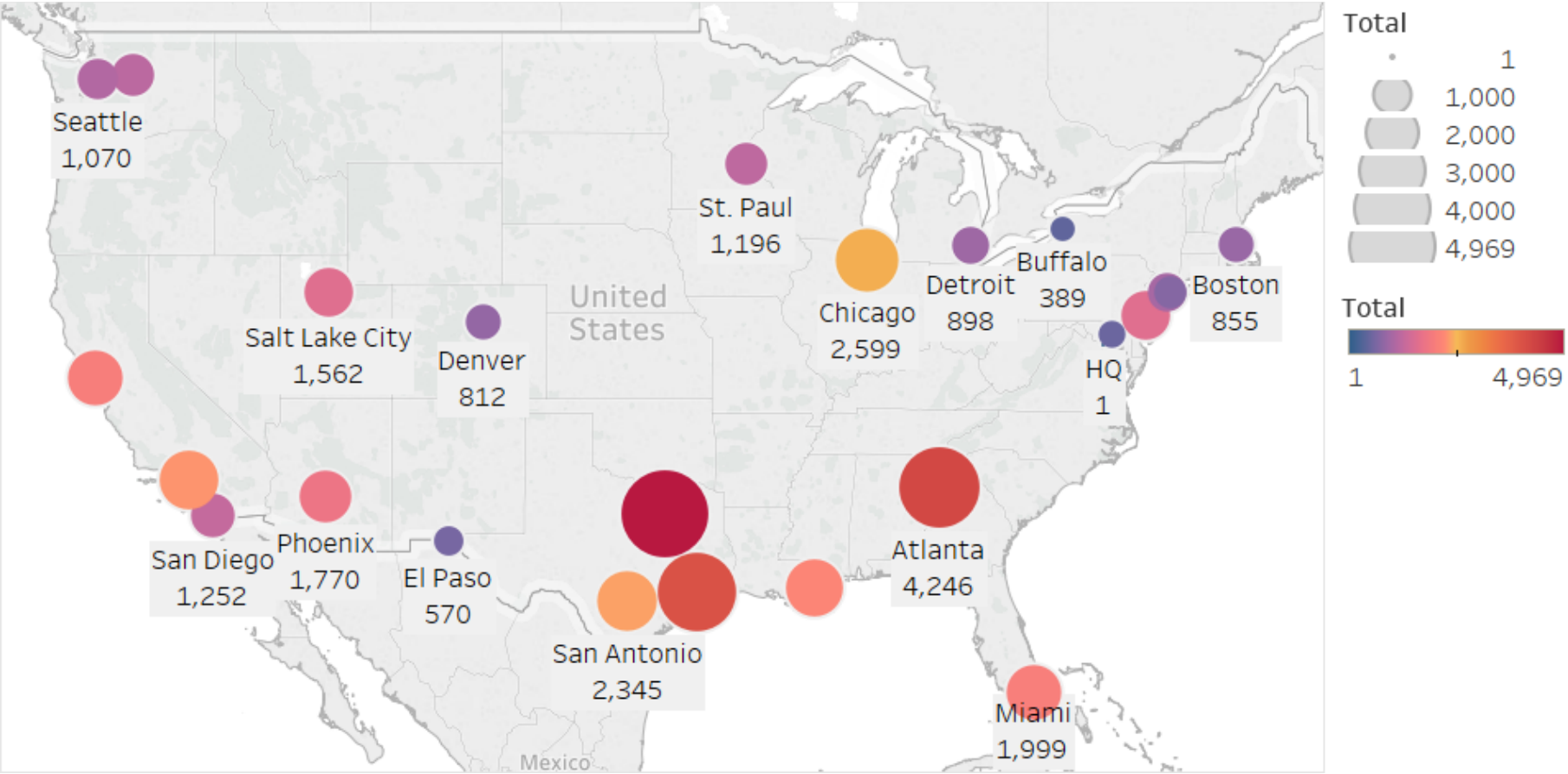

ICE/ERO administrative arrest data, 1/20/17 – 4/29/17

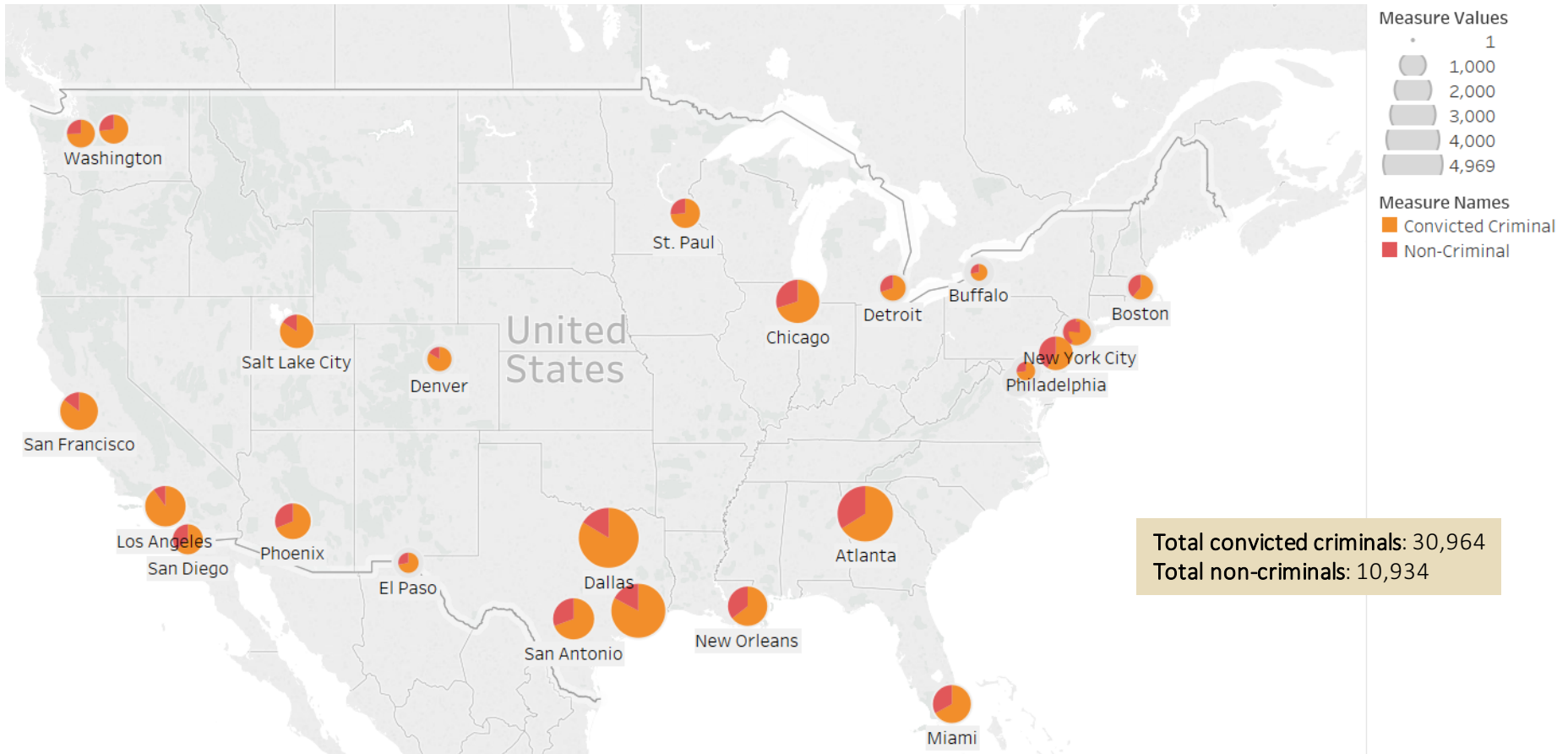

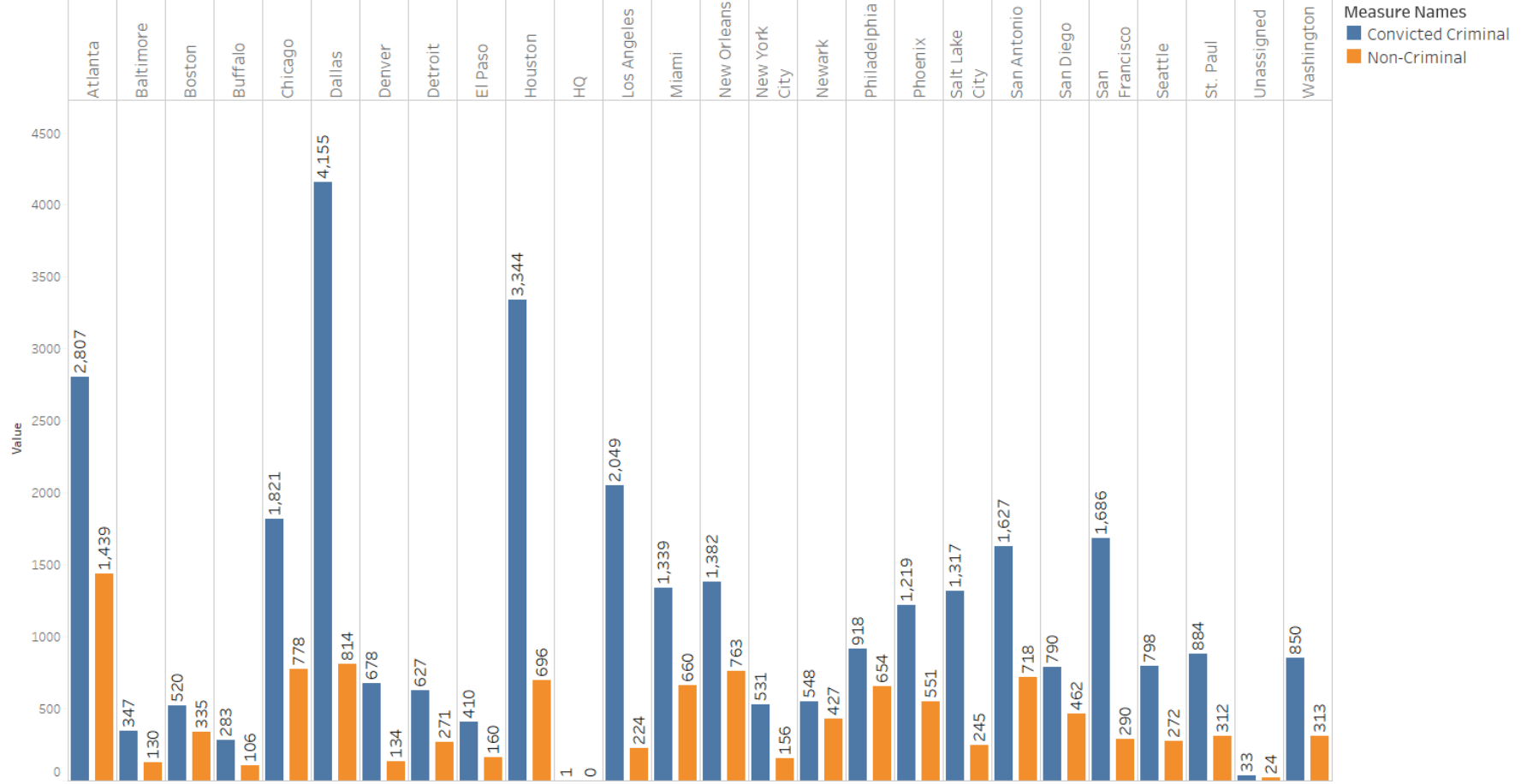
