
CBO estimates that by 2026, 22 million fewer people will have health insurance than under current law

Analysis

- These estimates are based on CBO's June 2017 scoring of the BCRA
- In 2017, the elimination of the individual mandate would result in about 2 million additional people becoming uninsured
- In 2018, about 14 million more people would be uninsured, relative to the number under current law
- In 2026, 49 million individuals would be uninsured
