

The Senate measure contains \$164.1 billion in base discretionary funding for the Departments of Labor, Health and Human Services and Education

Analysis:

The bill contains \$164.1 billion in base discretionary funding for the Departments of Labor, Health and Human Services, and Education, and related agencies.

The bill also includes:

- \$36.1 billion, a 20% increase, for the NIH
- \$816 million, an increase of 440%, to battle the opioid epidemic
- \$1.9 billion in cap adjustment funding for preventing waste, fraud, abuse and improper payments in the Social Security, Medicare and Medicaid programs
- \$12 billion for the U.S. Department of Labor
