Heidi Heitkamp

- Incumbent Democratic senator
- Elected in 2012
- Former state attorney general
- Supported Keystone XL pipeline and constitutional amendment to require a balanced budget
- Announced candidacy September 2017



Dustin Peyer

- Firefighter
- Former Democratic candidate for North Dakota state Senate
- Announced candidacy April 2017



Kevin Cramer

- Republican congressman
- Elected in 2012
- Ran for Congress four times before he succeeded
- Has not announced candidacy

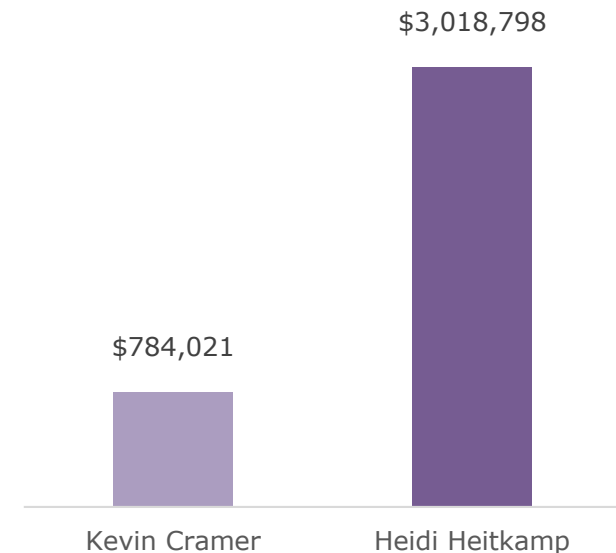


Tom Campbell

- Republican state senator
- Elected in 2012
- Vice-chair of Industry, Business and Labor Committee
- Announced candidacy August 2017
