
North Dakota





- Dakota Carrier Network's CCI Broadband project, funded by the NTIA, aims to provide high-speed fiber connectivity to more than 175 largely rural and underserved North Dakota critical community anchor institutions, including public safety entities, schools and government agencies
- **Senate Bill No. 2040** made property used to deploy telecommunications services exempt from sales and use taxes
