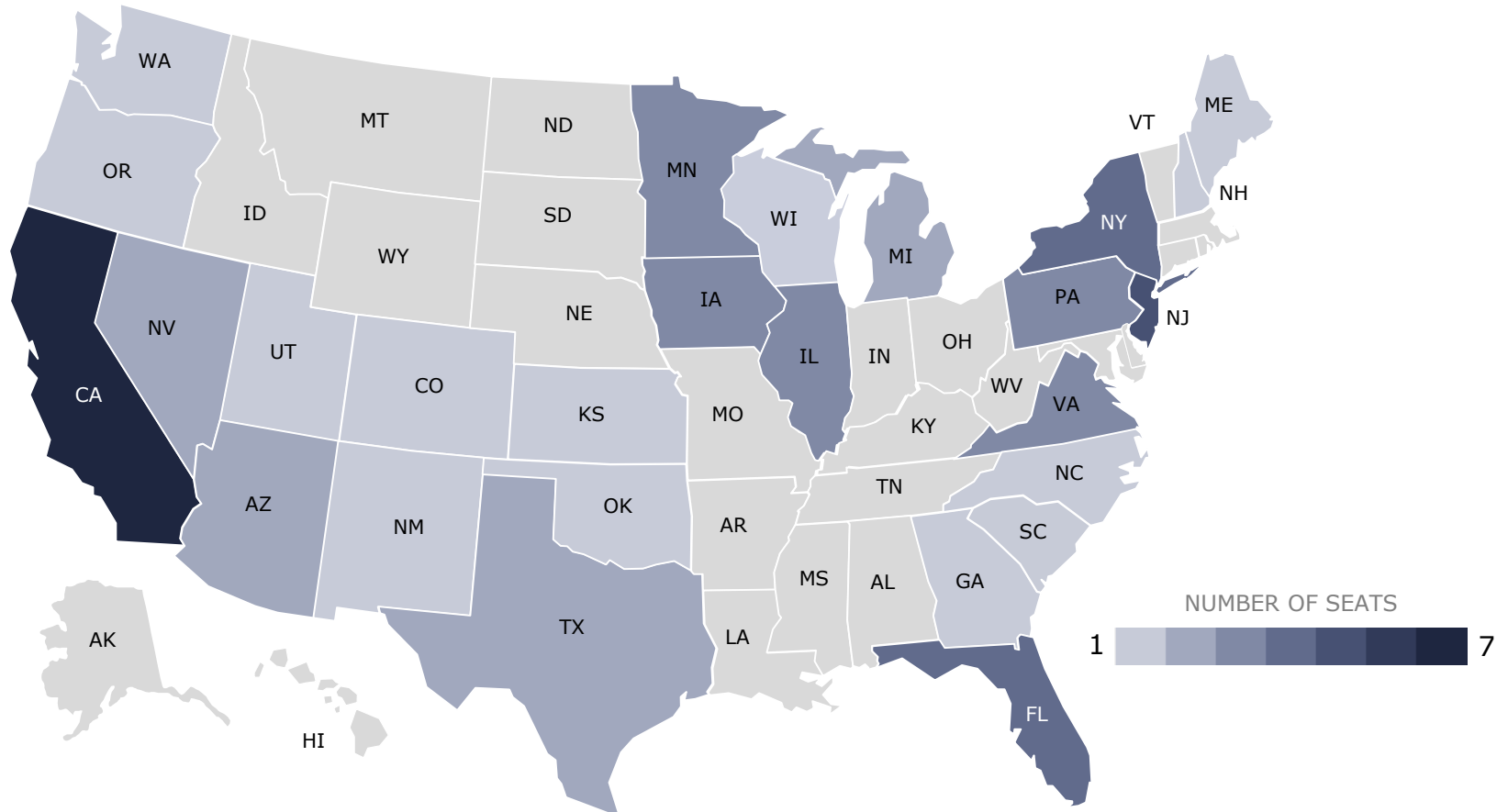


# House Republicans' 2020 election strategy targets 55 Democrat-held congressional seats
