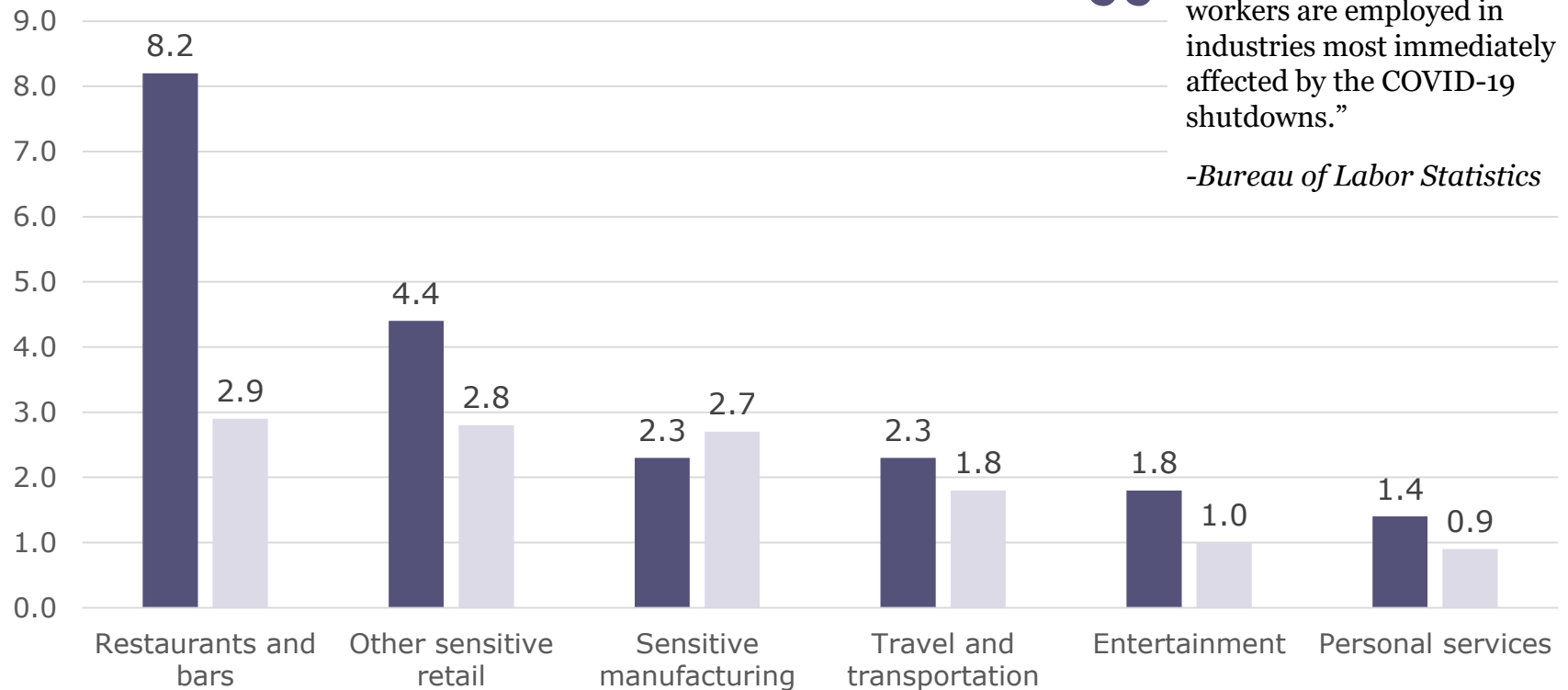


Sectors most impacted by COVID-19

Employment losses in top sectors

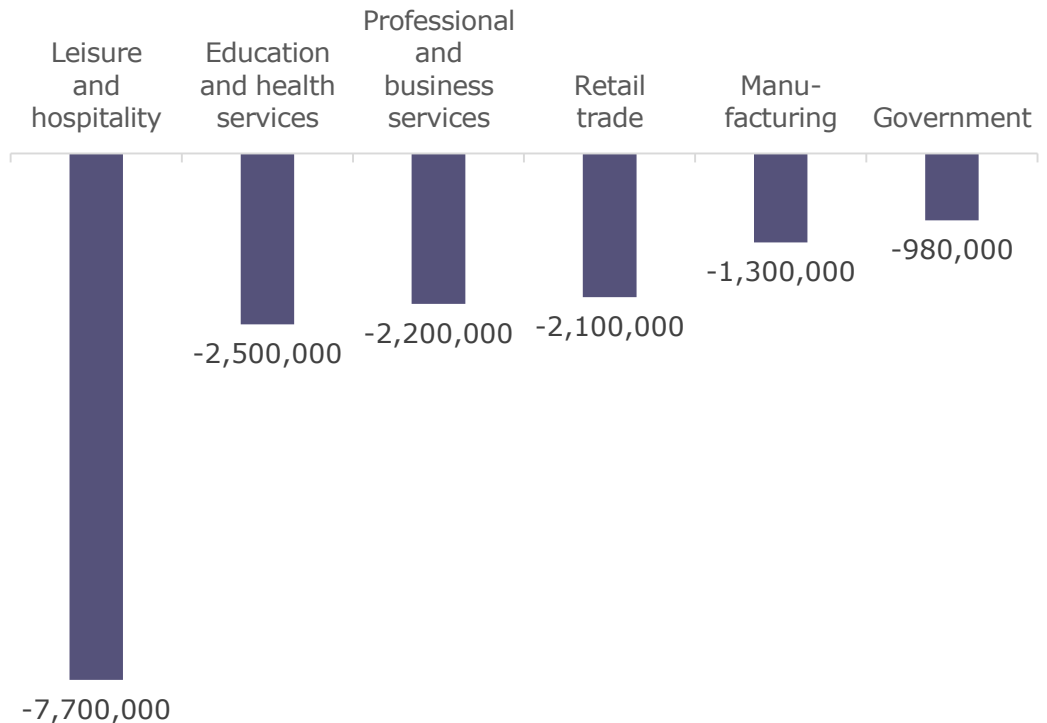
April 2020 employment



- According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, **20.5 million jobs were lost** in April across all major industry sectors, particularly those in leisure and hospitality
 - Nearly 75 percent of this decrease occurred in **the food and beverage industry**, where 5.5 million jobs were lost in April
- Employment declined by 1.4 million in **health care** as offices of many health care practitioners remain closed
- 1.3 million jobs in **other services** were also lost, with heavy losses in personal and laundry services
