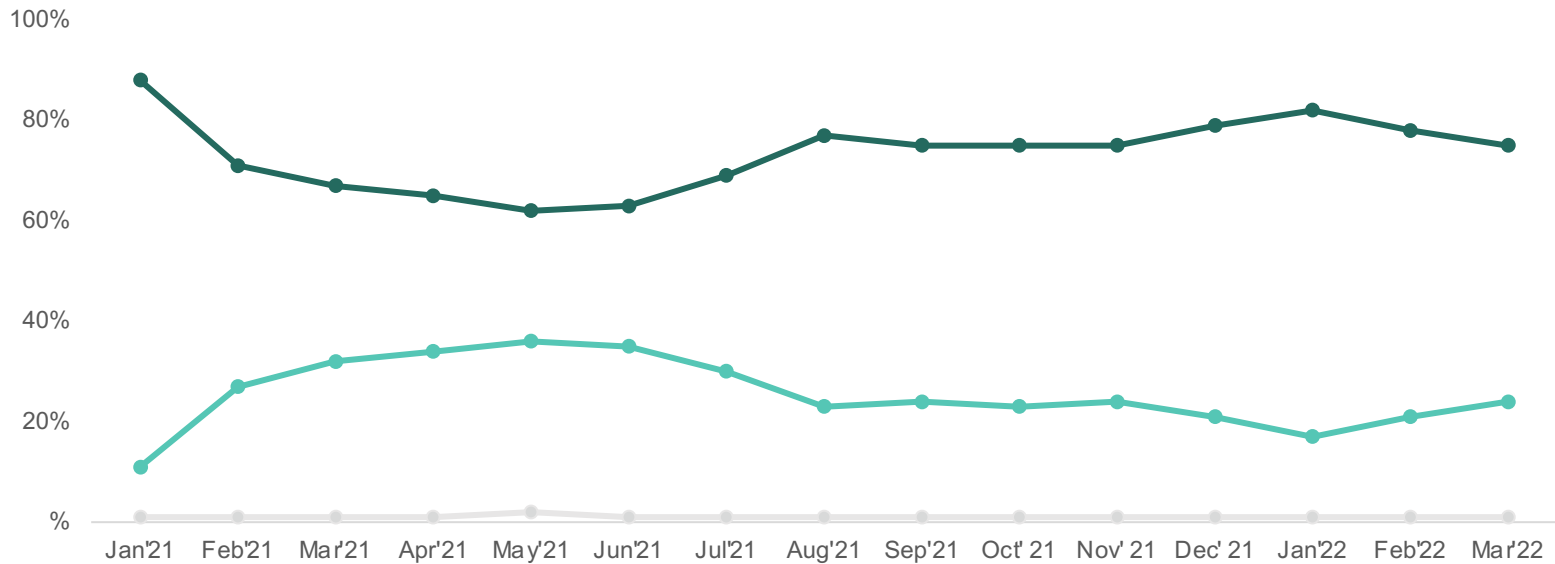
Most US voters are dissatisfied with the way things are going in America

In general, are you satisfied or dissatisfied with the way things are going in the United States at this time?

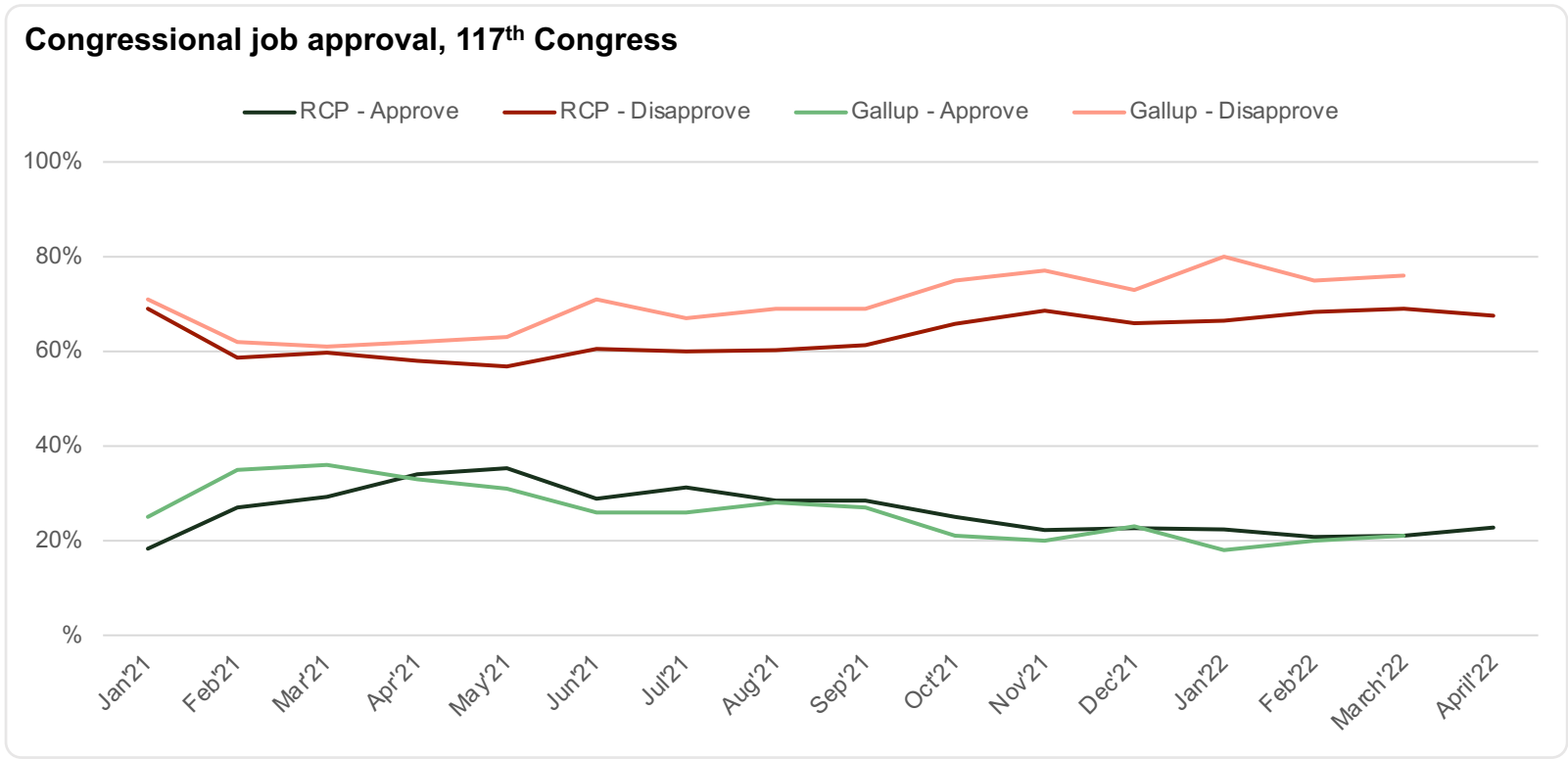

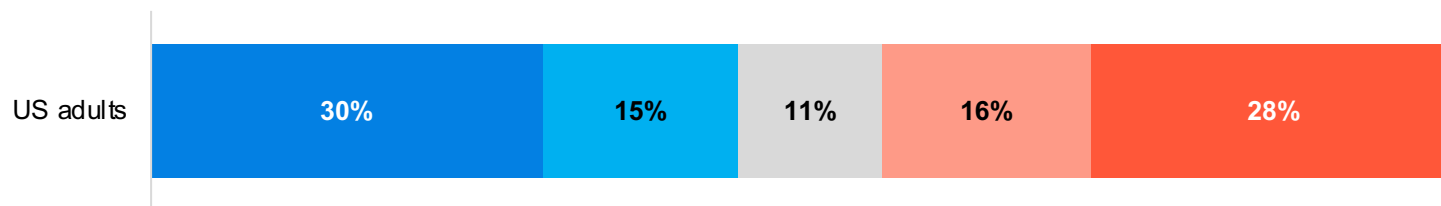

Democrats currently hold a one-point advantage, but midterm turnout will decide the next Congress



40% of Americans identify as political independents; although 74% of independents lean towards a party

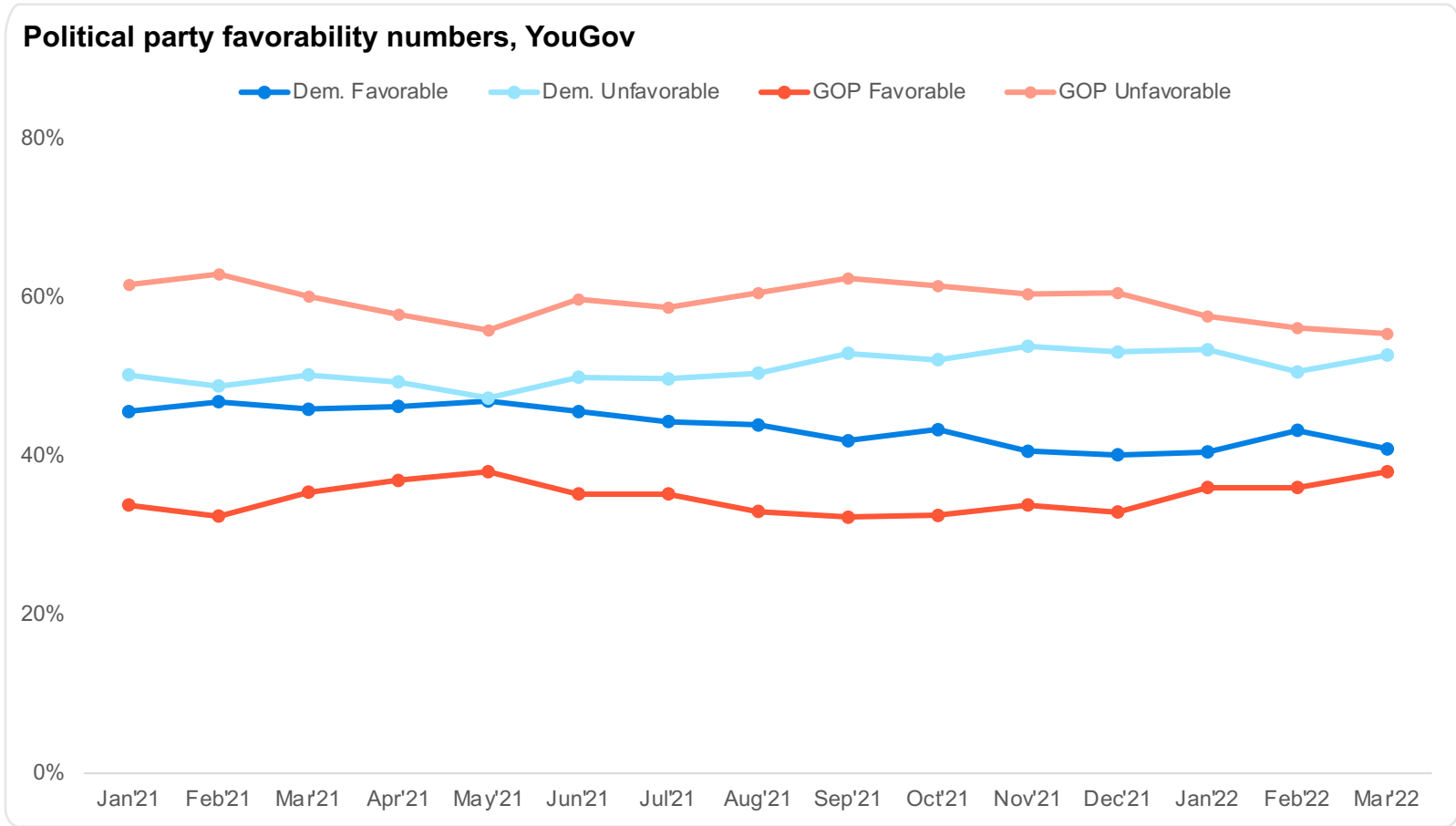


The number of US adults who identify as Republican leaning has increased six points from the beginning of 2021



Democratic affiliation is 6 points lower than when Biden took office

Favorability numbers have remained stable, but more voters hold an unfavorable view of the GOP
